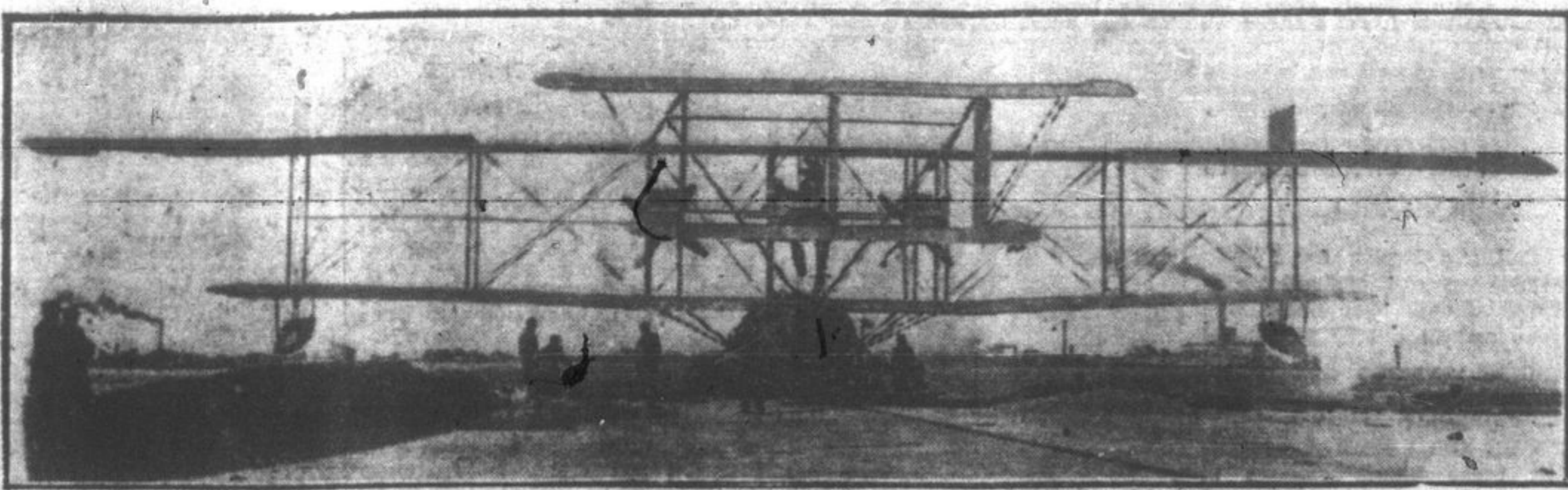

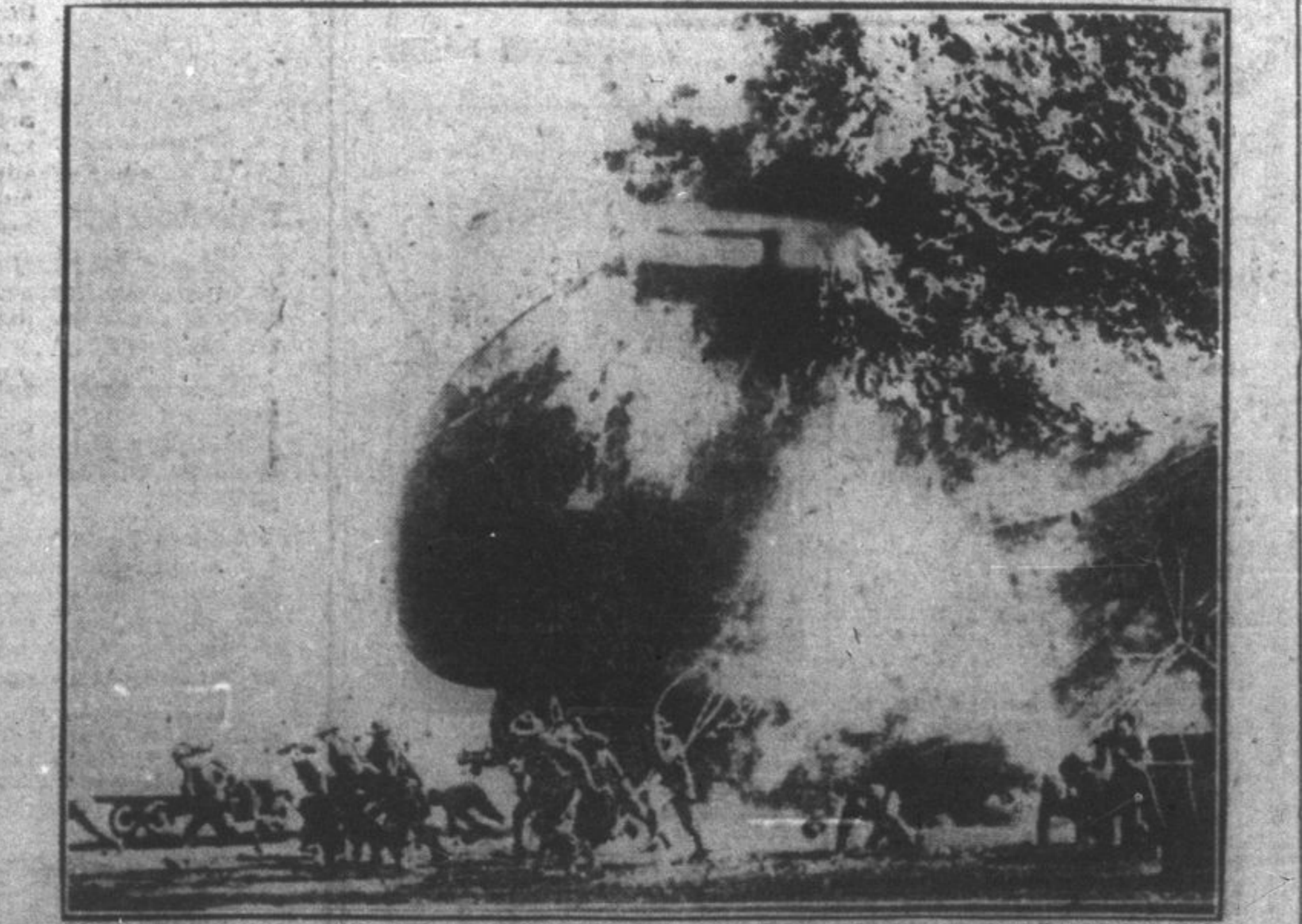
Good Work Of Red Cross.
