

The crowd continued their rowdy tactics outside the grounds and trolley cars were attacked with stones and windows smashed. Intense enthusiasm was shown in the semifinals, 20,000 people turning out to see Linfield and Shelborne battle for supermacy without scoring a goal, while Glentoran and Belfastt Celtic drew a crowd of 16,000.
