Over the Appointment of W. St. Plerro Hughes. Montreal Gazette.

One of the purposes of the Civil Service Commission is to select for appointment worthy and capable men. It is not always easy even under the plan of competitive examination to choose the one who subsequently will justify the method of choice, and in respect of higher offices in the service to which the rule of three does not apply the difficulty becomes greater, yet the recognition of merit and desert is always a safe guide to public approbation and to worthy service. A case in point is the selection by the Civil Service Commission of Major-General Hughes for the position of superintendent of Dominion Penitentiaries. Gen. Hughes has other claims, we believe stronger claims, than having served his country in a conspicuous way during the war. He comes of a fighting family in a military sense, —just the pretitient and neatest watch you have ever seen.
