PUT ON NEW TRAIN VIA C.P.R. TO WEST

It Will Be a Limited Train and Will Save a Day to Vancouver.

Montreal, May 16.—Travel conditions in Canada, particularly in connection with east and west business, have improved so much since the declaration of the armistice that the Canadian Pacific Railway has decided to run, commencing June 1st, a new daily limited express train, to be called the Trans-Canada Limited, connecting Montreal and Toronto with Vancouver which will reduce the transcontinental trip to less than four days and save a full business day to passengers leaving Montreal or Toronto for Winnipeg, Calgary or Vancouver.
