**THE WORLD'S TIDINGS IN BRIEF FORM**  
Tidings From All Over Told in a Pointed and Pithy Way.  
Cheese sold at Watertown, N.Y., at 30 cents a pound.  
Fire in the lumber piles at the Chaleur Bay Mills, N.B., across the river from there, early Saturday destroyed nearly half a million dollars' worth of lumber, the property of the British Government. The mill was saved.  
Because the Guelph city engineer put a foreman over them to see that they did their work properly and paid him 2-1-2 an hour more than they were getting, a number of the men employed in cleaning up the streets went on strike.  
Street car service in Detroit ended at 4 o'clock Sunday morning, and a city of a million people has only private autos and a pitifully inadequate trolley service as a means of transportation.  
"JUST A PAIR OF KIDS."  
Comment of St. Catharines' Magistrate in Settlement Case.  
Under the heading of "Love's Young Dream Shattered," a St. Catharines paper makes reference to the case of the eighteen-year-old youth and sixteen-year-old girl, who eloped from this city a week ago, but who were rounded up by the girl's brother before the marriage could be performed. It says the youth was remanded on a charge of falsely swearing in an affidavit of the girl's age in securing a marriage license, and adds:  
Magistrate Campbell entered upon a disquisition on how much a young girl of sixteen knows about "true love." "You are just a pair of kids in a lot of these cases here," he declared. "You are just as anxious to be divorced next week."

**A LITTLE CHILD KILLED.**  
Child on Track Mistaken For Bundle of Paper.  
Rentrev, June 7.—Three-year-old Jean Coulas, sleeping on the rails, looked so much like a bundle of paper from the engineer's window of No. 52 express, near Kilmaleo, that the youngster met a quick death before the trainmen knew it was a precious little life that had been snuffed out between the wheels and the rails.  
Mr. and Mrs. W. Coulas, of the township of Hagarty, and parents of the child, had journeyed to Wilno that day, leaving the youngster in charge of an old lady. In the afternoon little Jean left the house, unknown to her guardian, who still thought she was in the yard. With childish disregard for danger, she walked one mile and a half to the railway track, and, evidently, tired out, had lain down to either sleep or play with the gravel of the embankment. No. 4 express was speeding into Kilmaleo. The engineer noticed what he thought was some paper ahead on the rails. It was not until his engine had raced passed the spot that he observed that, lying up in the swirl of dust, was a little child. Realizing then that something was amiss, he applied his emergency brakes, and the train was brought to a quick stop. However, the little child had been killed instantly. The crushed little body was taken into Kilmaleo.
