

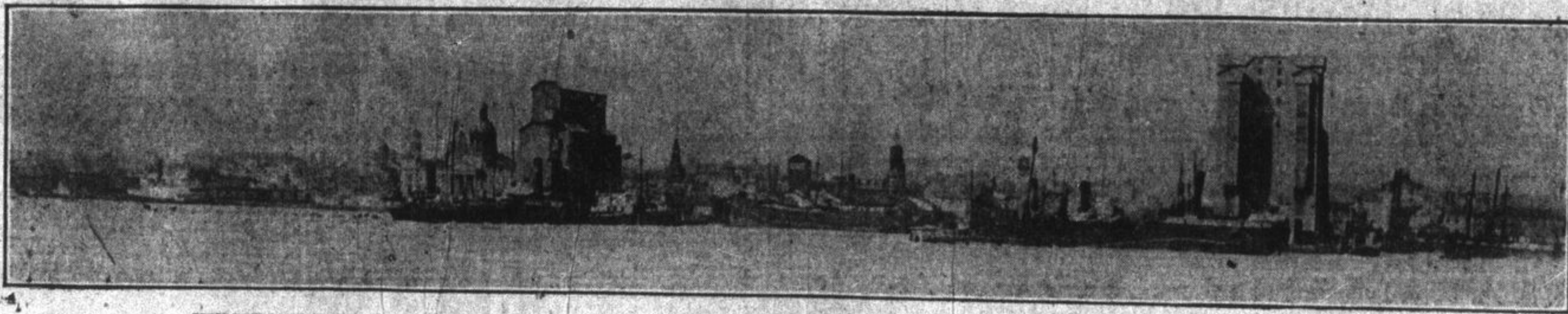

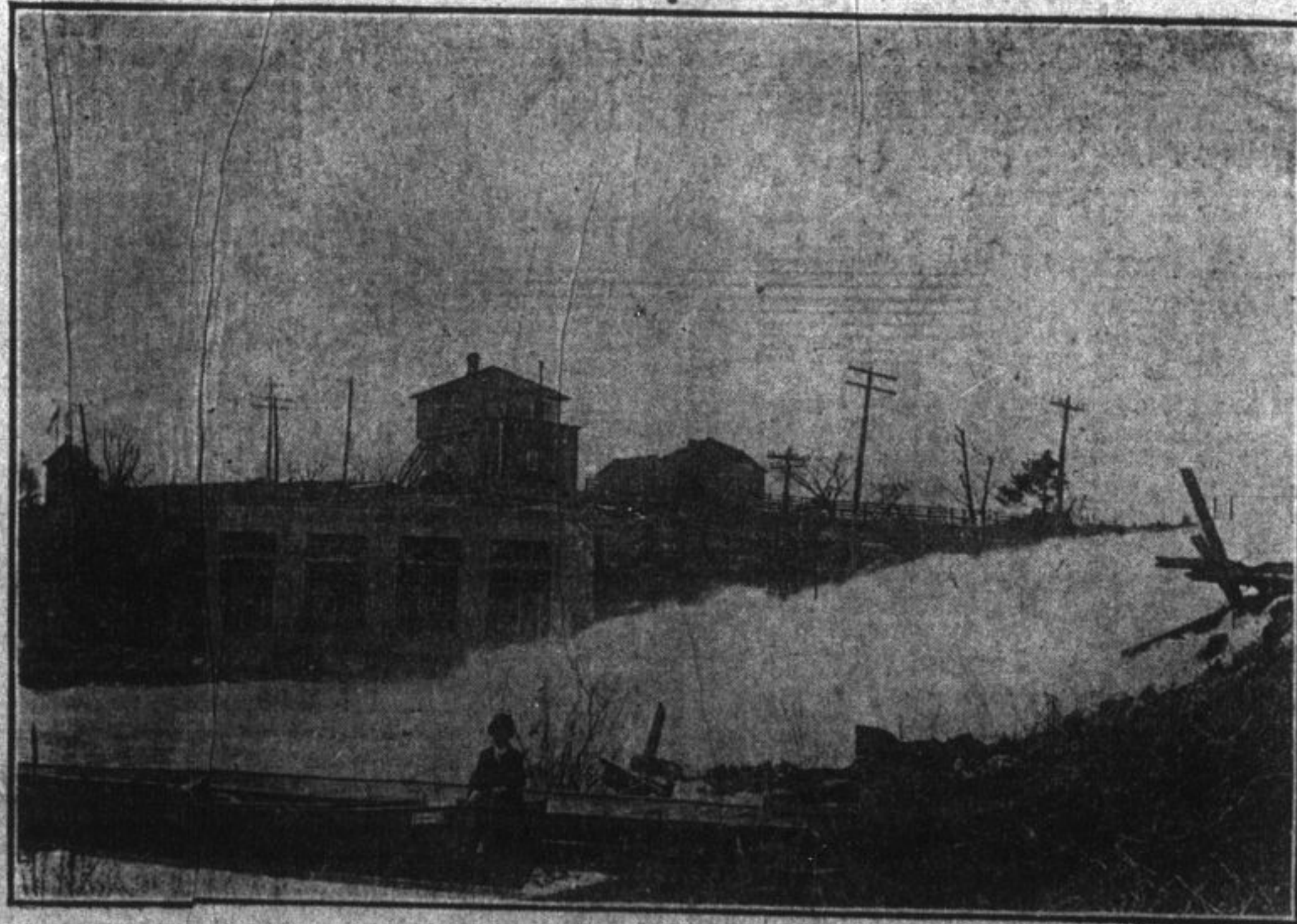

KINGSTON FROM THE HARBOR, SHOWING THE SPLENDID POSSIBILITIES OF THE WATER FRONT.



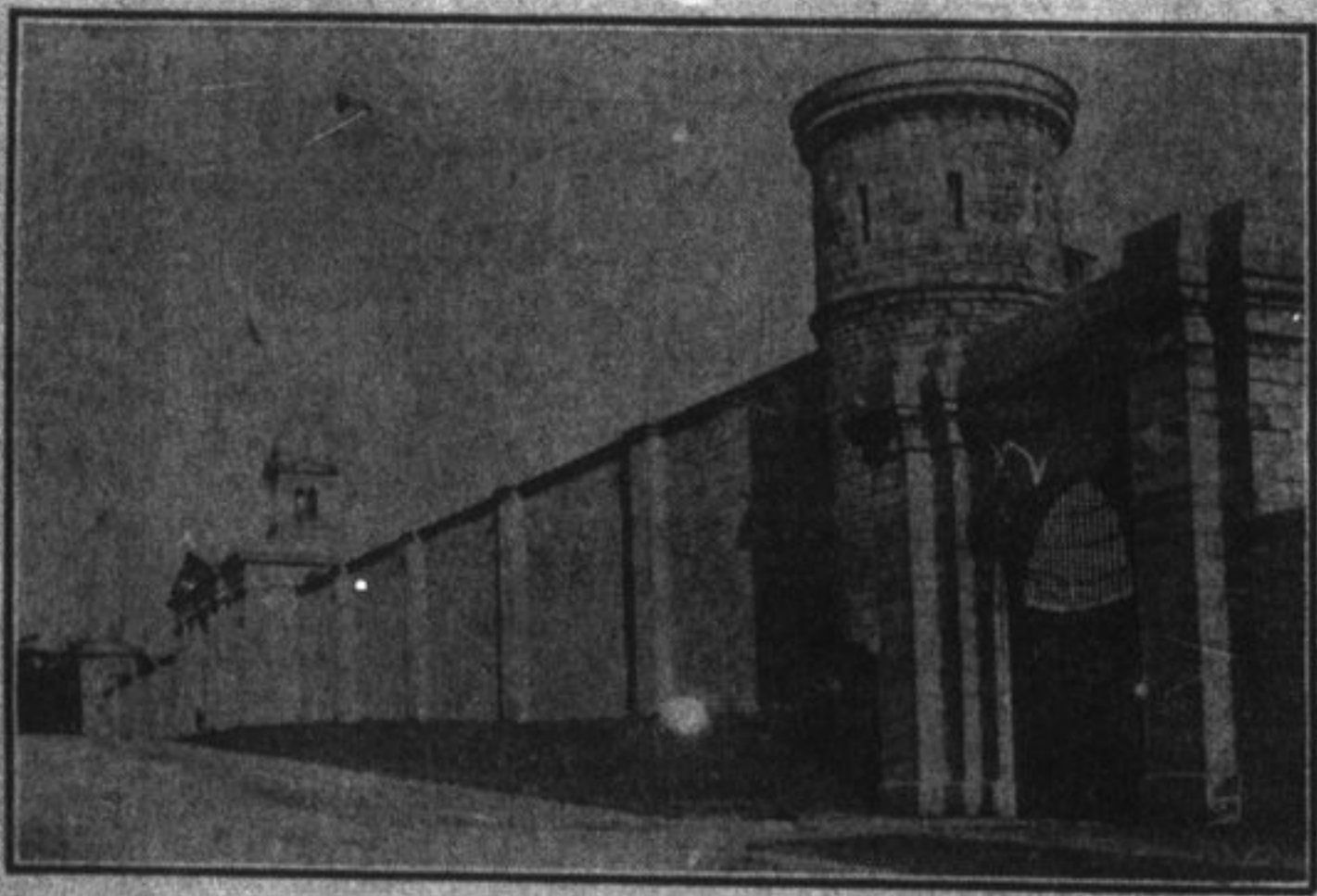
A VIEW OF PRINCESS STREET, KINGSTON'S MAIN BUSINESS THOROUGHFARE.



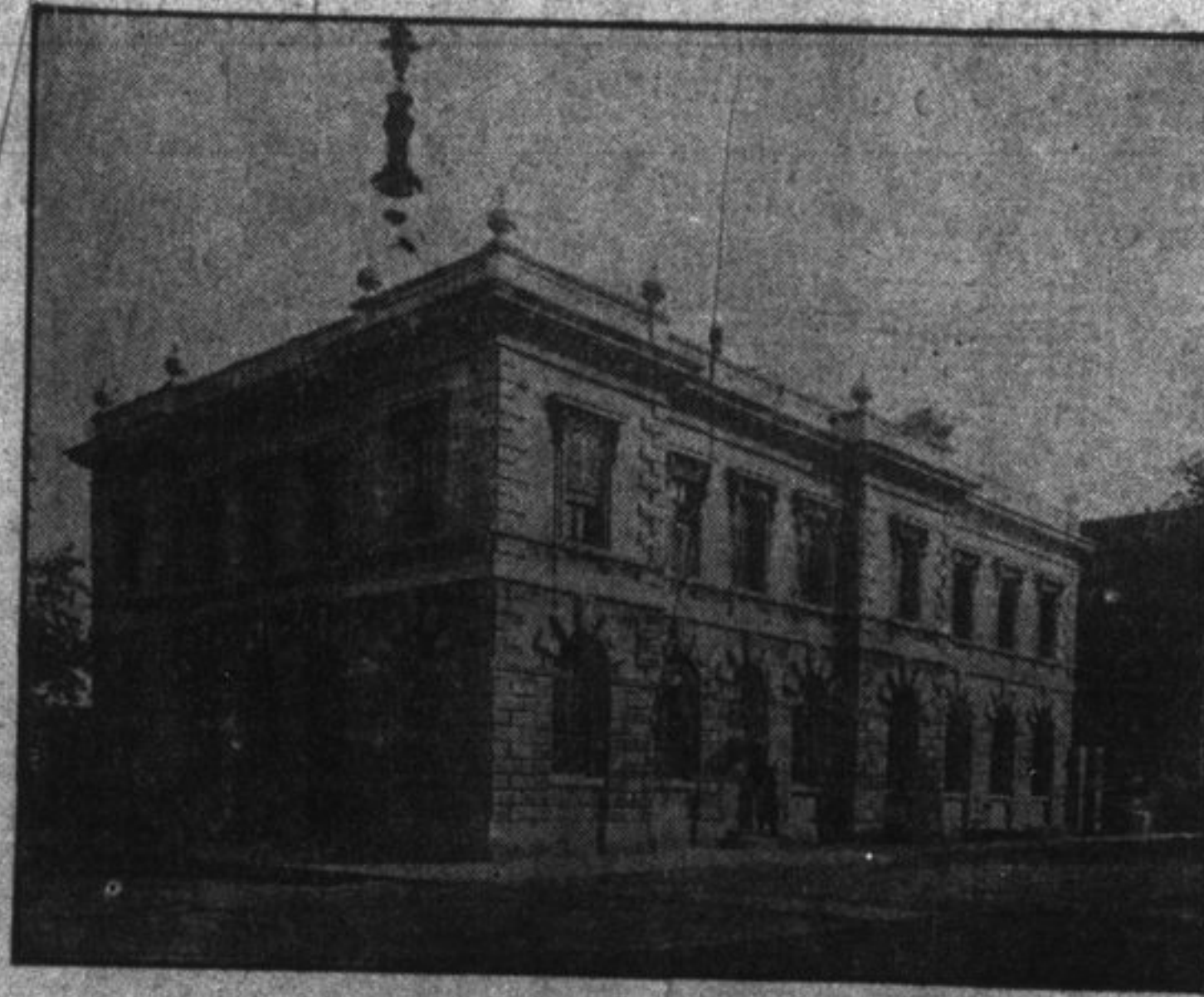

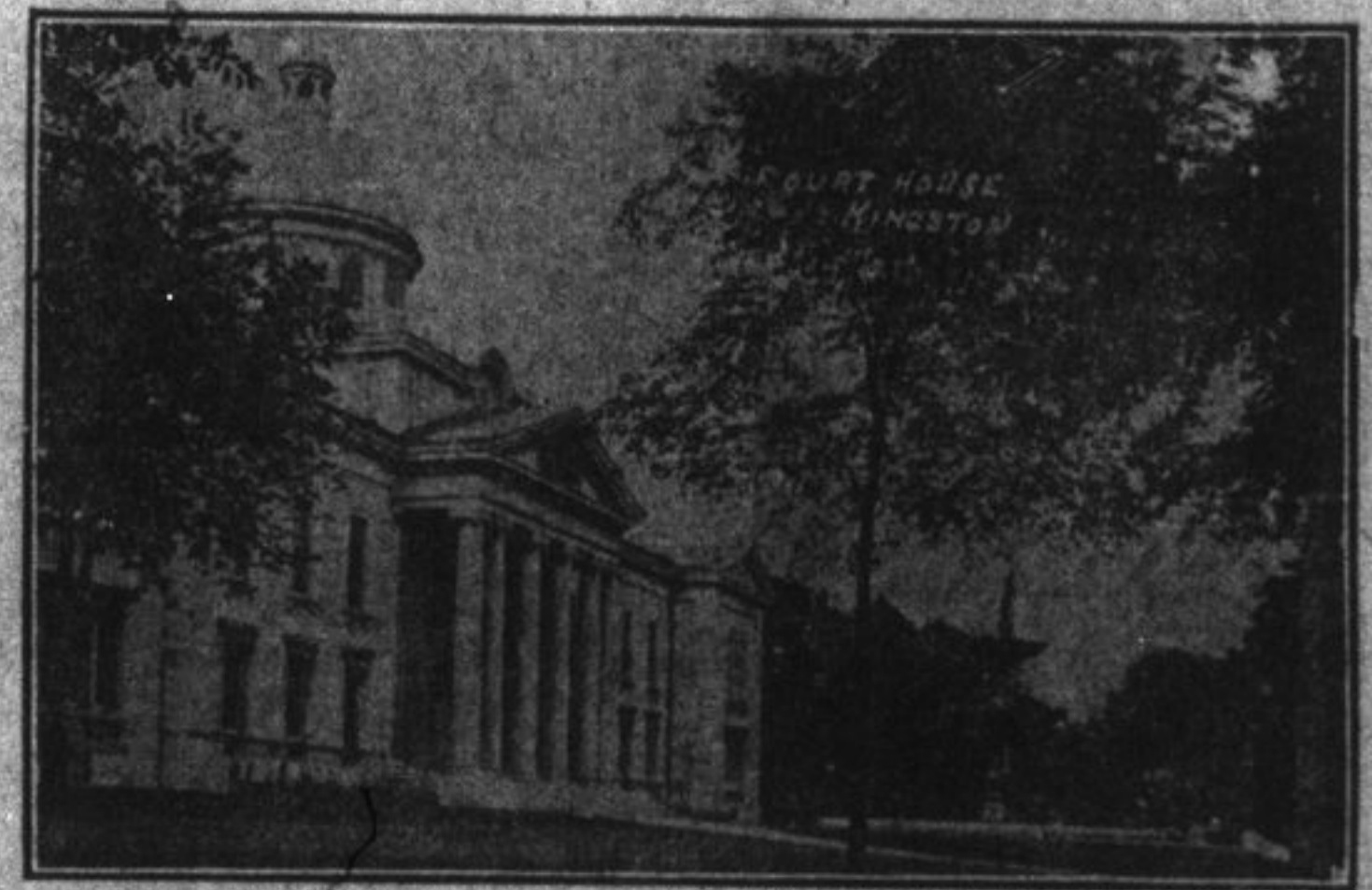
