Storage and Prices: The monthly report of the Cost of Living Commission, including details of practically all the cold storage in Canada, contains some interesting and valuable facts

On August 1st, says this report, there were in cold storage approximately two and a half pounds of butter, two pounds of cheese, two dozen of eggs, four pounds of pork, two and one-half pounds of beef, one-sixth pound of poultry and three pounds of fish per head of population in the Dominion

There are 20,943,991 pounds of creamery and 1,486,031 pounds of dairy butter in storage. This is approximately 1,250,000 pounds more than the total reported for a year ago

The eggs in cold storage amount to about the same as last month, 12,444,971 dozen. This is 18.62 per cent. above the amount stored last August in spite of the extremely high prices at which the eggs have gone into storage this year

The stocks of beef total 20,014,417 pounds. This is about one-third of the greatest amount recorded as being in storage at one time during the last two years

"Mutton and lamb stocks total 1,191,121 pounds. This is 26.9 per cent. less than a month ago and 45.73 per cent. less than a year ago

A FLAG WAS UNFURLED IN LABOR'S HONOR

The Prince Breaks Victory Loan Standard to Breeze at Ottawa

Ottawa, Sept. 2.—Two significant facts were emphasized yesterday morning when the Prince of Wales unfurled the first Victory Loan Honor Flag in front of the Parliament Buildings at the conclusion of the ceremony in connection with the laying of the cornerstone of the new tower of the Parliament buildings

While the Labor Day parade was being held in this city, the Prince and his party, including the Prime Minister, members of his Cabinet and scores of members of Parliament participated in a ceremony which for many years will be associated with Labor's day

The Honor flags, the first of which was dedicated and unfurled, are to be awarded, as was done last year, to every city and district which exceeds its quota in the campaign
