

There is no diminution of fulness above the knees in any of the new garments. The skirts are widened to seventer century proportions in some of the extreme models. It is not possible, therefore, that one should wear capes in the Roman toga fashion with a seventeenth century hoop skirt beneath it.

It is to meet this new movement in clothes that the cape of the season has a wider hem than its predecessor. It also has a cape across the shoulders in the English fashion. First there is a long cape to the knee, which is not drawn in at the hem, but cut slightly narrow at the seams so that it will not fly with the four winds of heaven; on top of this foundation cape is a short one that hangs to the waist, fitted at the shoulder with a slight ripple at the hem. The arms come through long slashes in the

oundation cape.

It is a well-known version of an old sporting cape for men and women and it has been returned to favor without warning and is well received. It is rarely made in solid colors. Large and small checks and plaid are plenti-fully sprinkled over the new fabric,


