The reason that Americans feel that satin capes have had their day is the generous supply of them in the department shops and the fact that the French women begin to wear cloth capes even in the afternoon.

SUCCESS FOR THE OVERBLOUSE

Here's wishing an extended term of success for the overblouse! You know last summer we had frequent intimations to the effect that the overblouse that had a plenum that extended down to the hips was done for. If there was any plenum at all it would be a short ruffle just below the belt.

But now from all quarters comes the report that women are favoring the overblouse for autumn and you yourself may have planned to invest in some garments of this sort. For one thing, the overblouse makes a nice afternoon frock out of a separate skirt, and if you are planning to make use of last year's suit or suits you will do more to making something new out of the old skirt than would a blouse that terminated at the belt. Wide flowing sleeves, either short or long, are very much to be desired in the ready-made overblouse, because this type of sleeve needs none of that accurate fitting that is necessary with the high cuff if it is to look smart.

But don't imagine that you can buy one of these attractive overblouses for a song, because really the prices are high, and a blouse that is not at all remarkable sometimes fetches as much as forty dollars. On the other hand, if you "shop around" you are sometimes able to pick one up for as little as nineteen dollars or even a few dollars less, and in these days that is not a very high price.

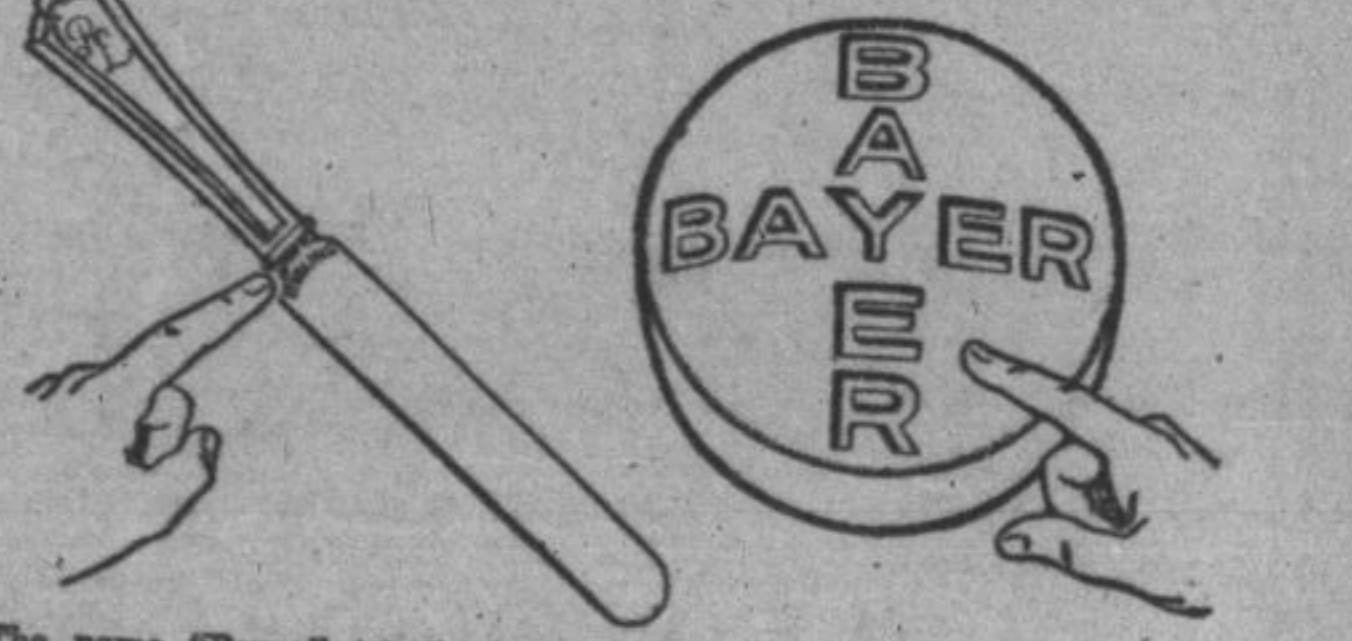
