The influenza epidemic, which began in the fall of 1918, imposed a heavy burden on the insurance companies. A report by the Department of Insurance of Canada gives \$9,803,000 as the amount of influenza-pneumonia claims incurred by Canadian and British companies operating in the Dominion. Such a record suggests that precautions should be taken against a recurrence of the epidemic.
