Fifty-two years ago when the H. C. L. caused by the Civil war was beginning to drop and baseball players were discarding their "long pants" for uniforms, Harry Wright, a star of the National team of Washington, landed in Cincinnati and put red hose on his players and they became the "Red Stockings." Three years later after the "Red Stockings" had had remarkable success with their professional team, Chicago men were inspired to organize a rival professional club.
