May Be of White or Colored Material, to Suit Skirt With Which It is Worn.

The sketch shows a very smart little blouse of lace which will be found a valuable addition to the early fall wardrobe. It may be made of black, white or ivory-colored lace, or, if desired, a lace may be dyed to match the skirt with which the blouse is to be worn. Dyed laces have been very much favored during the last season or two. This blouse is finished at the waist with a narrow ribbon girle, and as originally designed the garment was made of ivory-colored champagne lace. The girle was of inch and a half wide double-faced satin ribbon, green on one side, black on the other.
