THE TURKISH CABINET IS MASQUERADING
Ostensibly Pro-Entente But Really Composed of Germanophile Young Turks.
Paris, Oct. 23.—Reports reaching French political circles hold that the new Turkish Cabinet which was formed October 16th, under General Aliriza Pasha and which is masquerading as pro-Entente, is in reality composed of Germanophile Young Turks. The Cabinet, it is declared, in these reports, is resolved to oppose, by all possible means, the decisions of the Peace Conference, and to continue the extermination of Christians in Asia in Britain at present.

3,000 CANADIANS STILL IN BRITAIN
But All Are Expected to Be Home Early in December.
London, Oct. 23.—It is reported on the best authority that Brig-General J. H. Macbrien, C.M.G., D.S.O., present chief of the overseas military forces of Canada, will be major-general of staff at Ottawa. The position was formerly known as chief of the general staff, and was held by General Gwatkin. Macbrien, who was formerly commander of the 11th Infantry Brigade, will thus be General Sir Arthur Currie's first lieutenant.
Gen. Macbrien will return to Canada, at the beginning of December, when all Canadian soldiers are expected to be home. Only about 3,000 are in Britain at present.
