FOUNDER OF INDIANA

ONE OF THE MANY NOTABLE SONS OF MONTREAL

After a Lengthy Discussion It Has Been Established That Francois Marie Bissot de Vincennes Was Born In the Ancient Canadian City on the Banks of the St. Lawrence River.

MONTREAL can be called the mother of the Canadian and American West, for men who were born in that city or were closely connected with its rise and progress, have bequeathed their names to the history or nomenclature of many localities on this continent; wit, starting with Jacques Cartier, who (1635) discovered the Montreal island and district, erstwhile called the Kingdom of Hochelaga, and gave the mountain its name of Mont Royal or Montreal; Samuel de Champlain, who after discovering Lake Champlain (1609), founded in 1611 the first trading post of Montreal and called it Place Royale, giving the adjacent island, St. Helen, its name in honor of his young wife. Who can also forget that it was from this trading station at the head of navigation (Champlain discovered (Lake 1615) the Ottawa river) the fur traders, Huron, Ontario and Nipissing and the near west? Then there is the Chevalier sans reproche, Paul Chomedey de Maisonneuve, who organized the first permanent settlement and called it Ville Marie (1642). Nor must we forget the discoverers of its Jesuit missionaries, such as Chaumonot (with Brebeuf), discoverer of Lake Erie (1640), Isaac Jogues, the martyr, who, with Raimbault first explored the overland route from Quebec. ed to solve the mystery. Archbishop Spalding and Rev. M. Aldridge, on the authority of Bishops Buile and Hallandriere of the diocese of Vincennes, claimed him to be of Irish extraction, identifying him with one frequently spoken of as Moran of Vincennes, and they had with them Judge Law and the historian Dillon. It is now clear that this error arose from one of the Vincennes names being "Morgane"—not unlike Moran in utterance.

M. Roy, with Shea, Tanquay, Sulte and Canthorn, previously identified de Vincennes as a Canadian, fixing his family name and origin; but he erred in making the hero into his own father—Jean Baptiste Bissot de Vincennes.

In 1897 Major Edmund Mallet, born in the United States, but of Canadian origin, published a study in English and French on de Vincennes, which, while being a summary of the controversy, was an appeal for aid and for a more serious study, so as to obtain a definite solution of the identification of the founder of Indiana. But still not absolute proof was forthcoming.
