**Amusement Tax Stays.**  
Toronto, March 4.—There is no prospect of the lifting of the so-called "war tax" now levied on tickets of admission to theatres and other places of amusement in Ontario, Hon. Peter Smith, announced.

"Not while I retain my senses," declared the Provincial Treasurer. "That is not a war tax, it is an amusement tax. More than that, it is a good revenue producer, and we want all the revenue producers obtainable at the present time."
