MAN, WOMEN AND WHISKEY

A CASE HEARD BY POLICE MAGISTRATE FARRELL. A Young Man Fined \$200 and Costs for Having Liquor — Offered Some to Woman, Who Took It.

In Police Court on Friday morning, William Sleeman was found guilty of having liquor in a place other than a private dwelling house, and was fined \$200 and costs or three months in jail.

The evidence of a woman who, in former years had been an offeror, but owing to the work of the Salvation Army, she has kept sober for almost three years, was that she went down on Clarence street on Wednesday to visit a lady friend. When going up stairs she met Sleeman. Later while she was in the kitchen talking to her friend, Sleeman came up and said that he had some Scotch whiskey and asked her if she wanted a drink. The temptation was too great and she fell, and as a result while going home she was caught by the police.

The woman said that she drank one bottle of lemon extract before going down street and one after she drank the liquor. The woman of the house swore that Sleeman came into her kitchen and asked her if she wanted a drink of Scotch whiskey, but she saw him give the other woman a drink out of the glass, but she would not swear it was whiskey, although she thought that it was. Both witnesses stated that Sleeman had been drinking.

Sleeman told an altogether different story. He stated that he borrowed a glass from the woman, went down to the second floor and had a drink of water, and also gave one to a young man in his office. After taking a drink, he went up stairs to where the two women were sitting and took the glass containing some water and asked them to have a drink. He thought the water would act as a "chaser." A witness for the

defence said that he did not notice any whiskey nor would he swear that Sleeman was "fall." In summing up the case, Magistrate Farrell said he was convinced that the women were telling a correct story, although they differed in one place. He was also convinced that the woman who lived in the house where the liquor was consumed, gave a frank story and he was also convinced that the woman who was charged with being intoxicated knew whiskey from water.

The woman was fined \$10 and costs on the charge of drunkenness.
