BEWARE IRISH BONDS

AMERICAN FINANCIAL WRITER SPEAKS PLAINLY.

J. Edward Meeker Warns Citizens of United States Against Encouraging De Valera's "Republic Bubble"—It Would Injure Relations With Britain, "America's One Sincere Friend in the Family of Nations To-day."

In "The Street," a New York financial weekly, appeared recently an admirable article by J. Edward Meeker, entitled "Investing in Irish Revolutions" and dealing with the effort of De Valera to float his \$10,000,000 bond issue for the well-known but imperfectly established Irish "Republic."

But Mr. Meeker thinks it is fairly obvious that the money is primarily needed to drive the British out of Ireland and he rather doubts that the sum asked for is sufficient for this purpose and also for carrying out the subsequent program.

Unless the United States wants war with Britain—"our single sincere friend in the family of nations to-day"—the American Government ought to silence the "collection of cranks, Socialists, pacifists and former pro-German traitors to this country who keep up this continual caterwaul about Ireland, and these continual attempts to embroil us with Britain."

Mr. Meeker also quotes from a New York alderman, one of the esteemed Quinn family, who calls the enterprise "political panhandling, and says that De Valera is doing just what the United States Government is exporting "Reds" for attempting. It is to be noted that Mr. Meeker's article will be circulated in England, where much resentment has been excited by the reception given to De Valera in the United States.

Fiends Torture Negroes

ONE of the most horrible pamphlets to reach Canada in recent months is entitled "An Appeal to the Conscience of the Civilized World," and is published by the National Association for the Advancement of the Colored People.

It gives the lynching statistics of the United States for the past thirty years, and contains some gruesome photographs of lynchings. The pamphlet says: "The following record, it is hoped, will make its appeal to those persons everywhere to whom civilization is something more than a name."

The pamphlet sets forth the fact that in the thirty years from 1889 to 1918, there have been 3,224 persons lynched in the United States, of whom 2,522 were negroes, and among them fifty women.

There is a terrible photograph in the pamphlet taken while a negro was being roasted to death. The features of some score of the lynchers are plainly revealed, so that it would be an easy matter for the authorities to arrest and prosecute the lynchers in this case if they desired to do so.

Perhaps the most shocking fact brought to the public attention by the pamphlet is the openness with which the lynchings for the most part, were carried out. They were announced in the newspapers in advance. Here, for instance, is a sentence from the Jackson, Miss., Daily News, of June 26, 1919: "John Harrison, the negro alleged to have assaulted an Ellenville young woman, has been taken to Ellenville and is guarded by officers in the office of Dr. Carter of that city."

In the Chattanooga Times, of Tennessee, there is the description, probably from "our special correspondent" or "our staff reporter" of the torturing of a negro named McTherron, who had shot two white men. He was chained to a tree and a bar of iron heated. In the course of his lively account of the proceedings, our staff reporter writes: "As the hot iron was applied to various parts of his body scream after scream rent the air, and his yells and cries could be heard in the ows."
