Plain and Plaid Materials Form
Garments for Sports.
May Be Made of Heavy Blanketlike
Wool or Light-Colored An-
gora Cloth.
Among the very striking array of
garments shown for sports wear this
year the golf cape combining plain
and plaid materials is one of the fa-
vorites. Such a wrap is shown in
the sketch. It may be made of a
heavy, blanketlike wool material in
bright Scotch plaid, with vest and
collar of white or light-colored an-
gora cloth. A belt of patent leather
or of velvet ribbon matching the pre-
dominating color in the plaid may
be used to hold the cape to the figure.
A tam to match will always be found
smart or a little sport hat, such as
the one sketched, may be worn, if
preferred.
These capes, now being worn in the
South and on the golf links of every
country club when the weather makes
going possible, are forerunners of
a wrap that will be popular in the
spring. One such wrap recently de-
signed is made of a striking plaid
blanketlike fabric in various color-
ings, finished all around with self-
fringe and held in with a belt of
patent leather. It is as loose fitting
as a cape, but is really a coat, with
clearly defined, though loose, sleeves,
and it is claimed for the coat that it
is a real economy garment, because
a very small quantity of fabric is re-
quired to make it.

LIKE DYED LACES
Vogue for Color in Every Type of
Feminine Garment.
Decoration is Being Generously Used
for the High Lights of
the Costume.
It may sound at first like painting
the lily to talk about dyed lace, but
in the tremendous vogue for brilliant
color in every type of feminine gar-
ment it is not a bit surprising. After
the first shock it is pleasant, in fact,
to see a georgette blouse, for instance,
in what is called "new" blue veiling,
an underblouse of tomato red fllet lace
allowed to show in the front in fllet
fashion.
Lace is being used extensively for
the high lights of the costume. It ap-
pears, for example, in silver to lighten
up a frock of navy blue georgette. The
stiff silver lace electrifies the hips, giv-
ing the fashionable outstanding line,
and is veiled by just one layer of the
soft georgette. It edges the neck and
short sleeves of the same frock.
Cafe au lait Lyons lace is used as a
foll in a blouse which is lined with
black chiffon and has a girdle of black
net tying in a bow at the back. One
of the loveliest of evening gowns is
entirely of gray lace with the inevi-
table bright color touch in the orange
ostrich pompon at one side.
Perhaps fllet lace lends itself best
to dyeing, but all the fine laces are no
exception to the new ruling. Some-
times several laces are combined on
one blouse. Fllet lace dyed a bright
orange, for example, makes flounces
over the shoulders of a shadow lace
blouse dyed brown with sleeves of net
in the same dark brown.
To lighten up the darker laces, the
navy blue, black and brown tinsel rib-
bons are used. Little folded flowers
of it, tiny bows and narrow twisted
girdles, all serve to add to the dressi-
ness of the dyed lace blouse or frock.
Beads, too, are being used to bring out
the richness of dyed lace. Often they
contrast with the lace, repeating the
deep color of the chiffon lining or they
work out the pattern of the lace it-
self.
Metal threads are also used to
bring out the lace pattern from its
dusky background. Where a whole
blouse of lace would be too thin and
delicate to top the suit skirt, jumper
blouses are made of velvet on silk
duvetya to bring the dyed laciness
down to earth.

WIRING IN EVENING FROCKS
Arrangement Extends Hips, Used in
Simple Round Neck and in
Short Sleeves.
Evening frocks, almost in every
case, show the wired-out hips and full
lines. The wiring is usually conceal-
ed by garlands of ribbon or flowers.
A jade blue gown is much ruffled
as to the skirt, and is also wired and
trimmed with wreaths of silver flow-
ers, which are placed partly on and
partly hanging below the edge of the
ruffles. The bodice shows no other
trimming than the silver garlands.
A lavender chiffon dress has the
simplest of trimming, just a row of
mauve velvet violets concealing the
wiring at the hips and the simple
round neck is wired as well as finish-
ed by the row of violets. Very short
sleeves are also wired in this manner.
The tunic of a frock of black taffeta
has inset at the sides two squares of
the heaviest of silver fllet, on which
are carelessly laid garlands of silver
flowers. This makes a striking note,
as one may imagine, for the silver
contrasts so strongly with the black.
The bodice shows just a wide band
of the silver fllet at the top, which
relieves the blackness of the dress.
The short sleeves are also silver.
