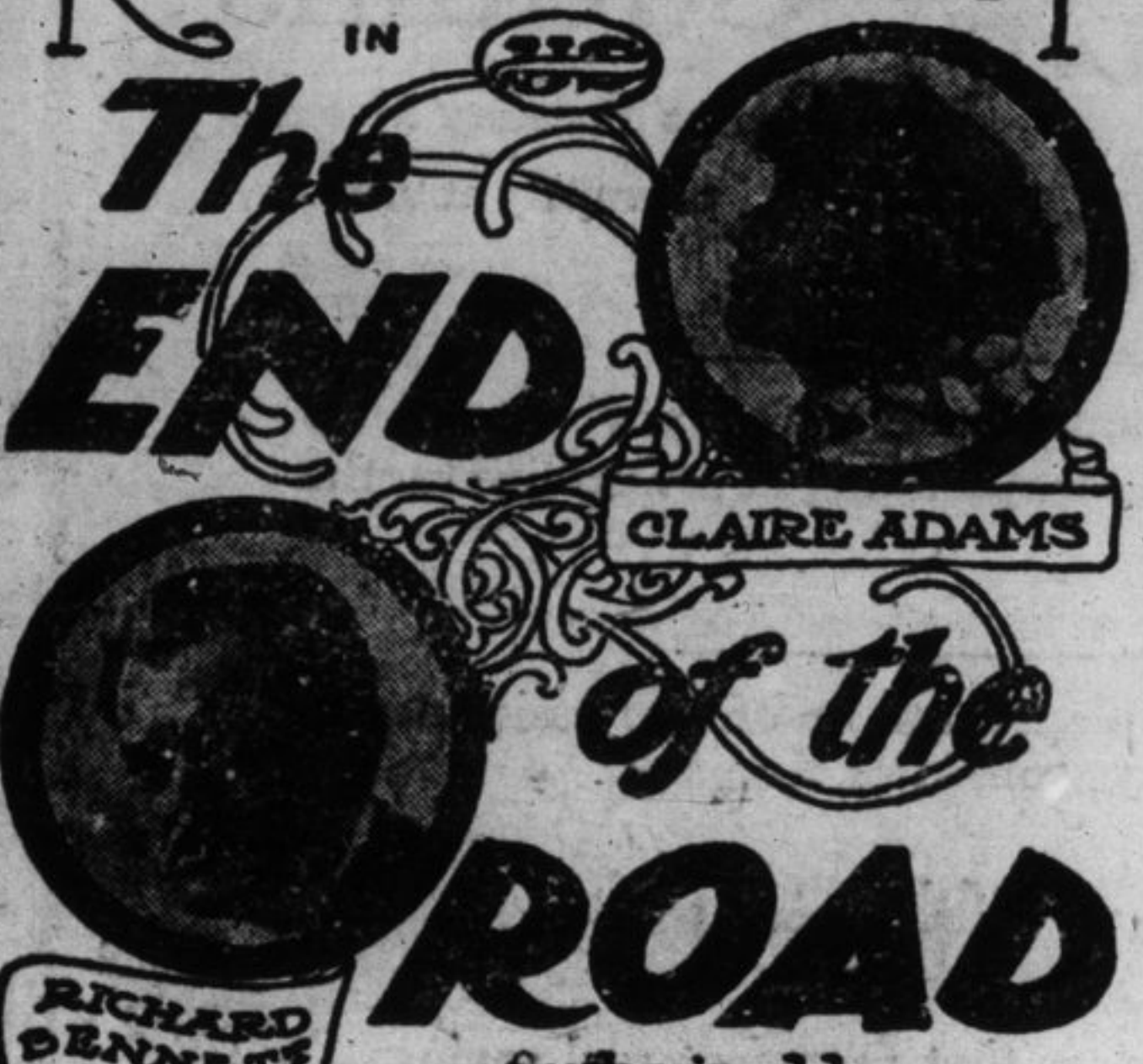

COAL IS TO DROP FIFTY CENTS A TON

Montreal, May 3.—Coal prices in Canada will be reduced half a dollar a ton following the withdrawal by the D. and H. railroad of a clause in their tariff calling for repayment in American currency for all charges on freight coming from United States points to destinations in Canada, and prohibiting the reimbursement of freight at the border.

Under the revised tariff Canadian coal importers will be allowed to pay freight charges in Canada on through hauls from the States in Canadian currency, thus saving the 10 per cent, tariff calling for repayment in American currency for all charges on freight coming from United States points to destinations in Canada, and prohibiting the reimbursement of freight at the border.
