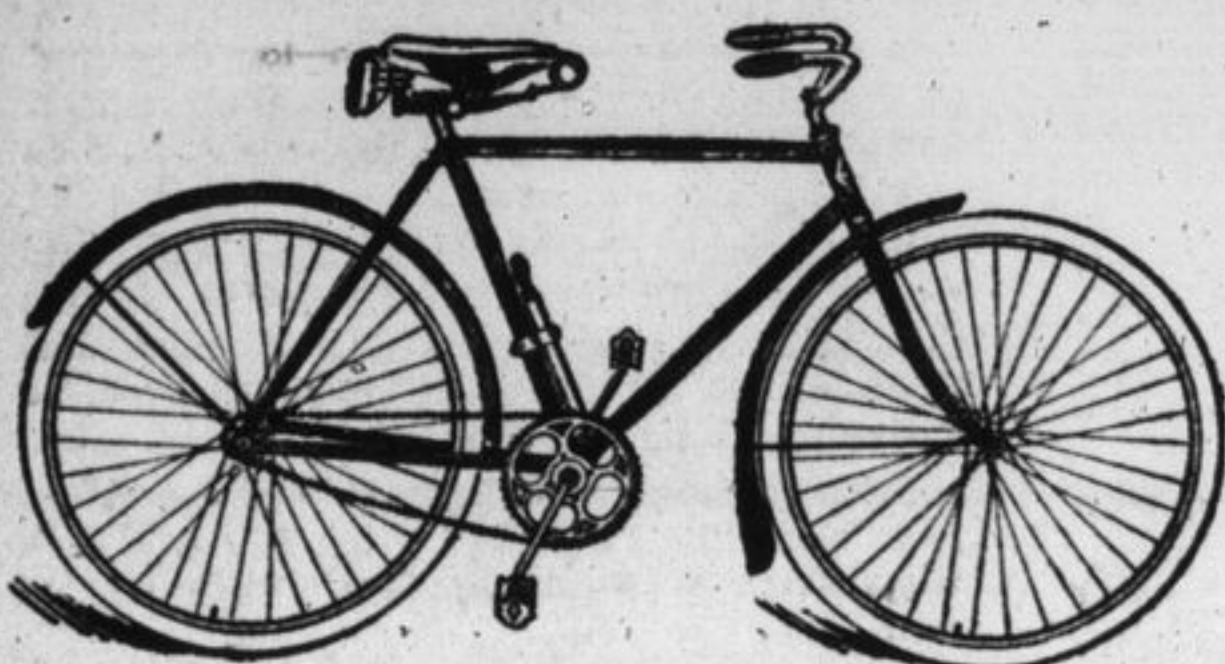

GOVERNMENT BACKS THE BRITISH TEAM

Official government recognition of the British Olympic Committee's efforts to secure a representative to compete in the Olympic games at Antwerp this summer has been made by the appointment of a committee from the House of Commons, of which the Speaker is President, to assist in the work.

This action is expected to lighten considerably the financial task of securing funds to provide for transportation and quartering of teams at Antwerp. It will also add impetus to the movement for a strong, creditable team which, owing to the slow collections of contributions recently, led to expressions of opinion that Great Britain's representatives would not be up to former standards. Under the new conditions, it is expected that the British team for the main events will number at least two hundred and fifty athletes.

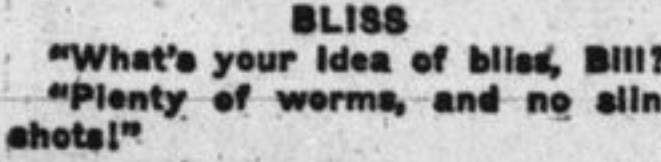

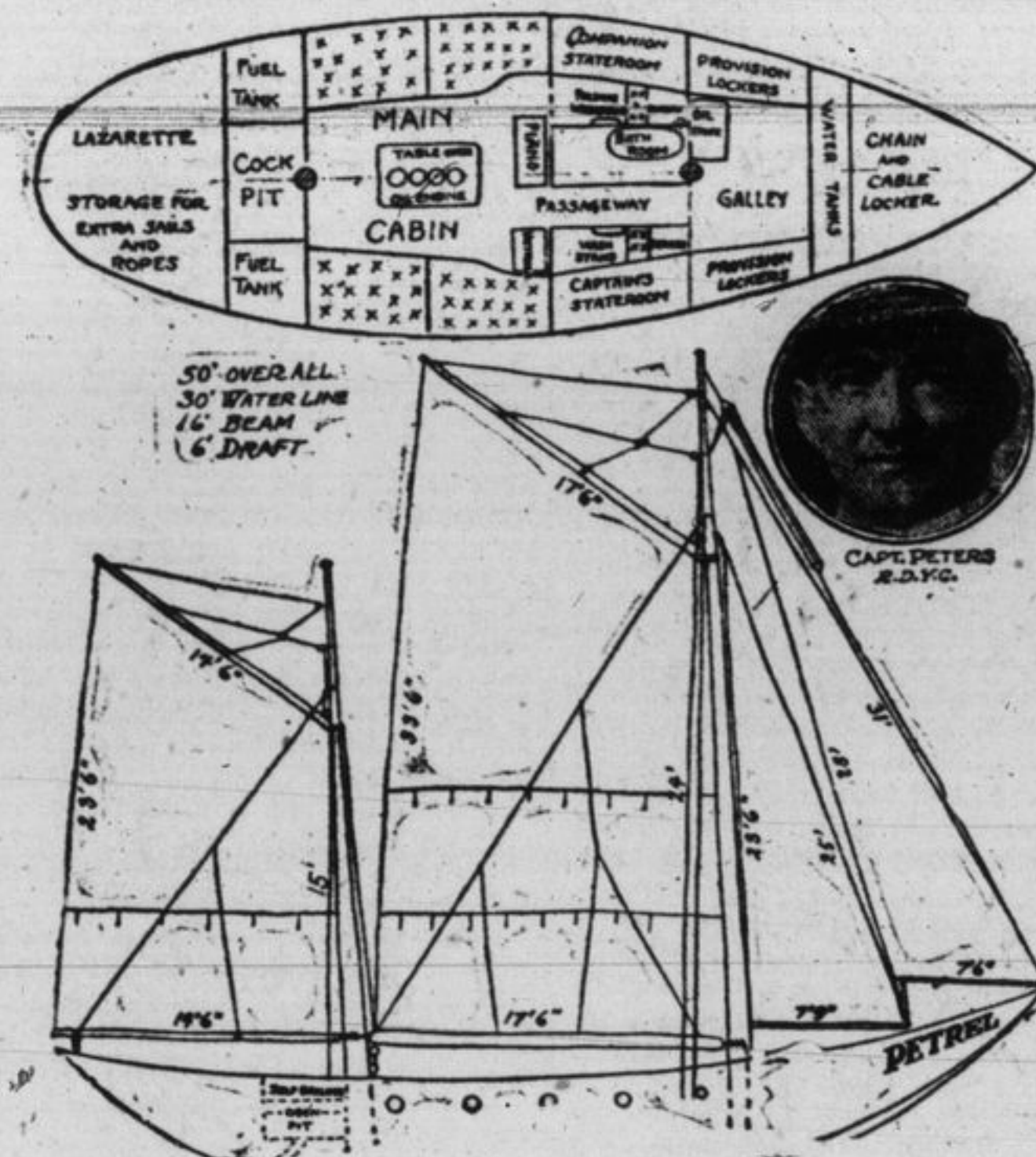

The animals were purchased from the two local men by Royal Tallman and Alexander M. Watson, agents for the latter's father, George Watson, one of America's foremost exporters of trotting blooded stock.

The campaigners which will soon tread the soil of England are Rose of Athens, a green mare, by McPherson, dam Maid of Athens, 2.15 1/4, and Lucille McPherson (4), 2.17 1/4, a granddaughter of the great Lucille, 2.07, sold by Mr. Burns; and Roxy McPherson, 2.20 3/4, by McPherson, dam Roxy, sold by Mr. Hax. The two record mares are eligible to the 2.21 trotting classes.

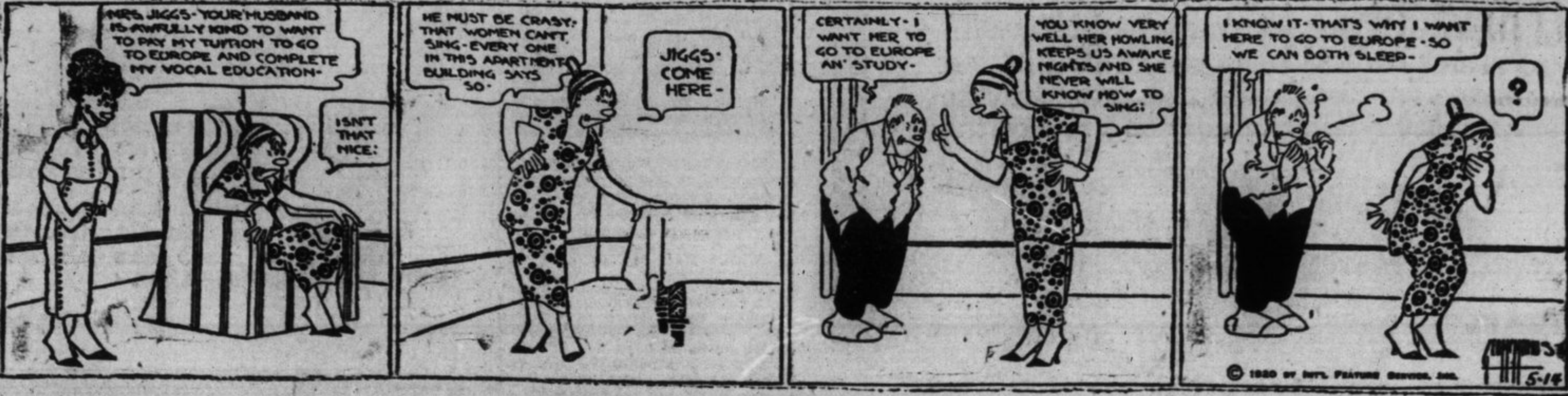
