When the big league managers scrambled for the Federal League talent following the breaking up of the outlaw circuit, Benny Kauff was the most sought of the third league's stars. They called him the Ty Cobb of the Feds, and New York millions won the fight for his services. But now we find Arnold Stutz, a recruit, batting and playing in Kauff's position for the Giants. It is not because of injury, for against right-handed pitching Kauff is in the game. McGraw has decided to use Stutz, who hits right-handed, whenever left-handers pitch for the opposing team. This is the first step of a slugger's deterioration. Meanwhile Eddie Rousch, another Fed outfielder, who was obscured by Kauff's prowess while the scrambling was going on, continues to bat in the clean-up position for the world's champions, no matter whether the other team uses right-handers or left-handers.

Since Eddie Fitzsimmons was credited with a victory over Lew Tendler, he has decided to issue a challenge to Benny Leonard for the lightweight title. Until the contest with Tendler in Philadelphia recently, Fitz was content to leave Leonard strictly alone, but the result of his match with Tendler has made him so confident that he now thinks he has a chance with the champion. On his record, Fitzsimmons does not appear to have much chance with Leonard. However, Leonard has yet to show portersiders. Harvard University will not defend its possession of the grand challenge cup, won at the English Henley regatta, of 1914, but a Harvard crew, rowing under the colors of the Union Boat Club, of Boston, is training for an attempt to keep the trophy in this country. All indications now are that this crew will be America's only representatives at the classic English aquatic meeting to be held July 1-3, except for possible entries in individual and doubles events.
