THE BRITISH OPEN GOLF CHAMPIONSHIPS

The British open golf championships which will begin on June 23 will be unusually interesting this year as there will be international competition with the two American players Walter Hagen and Jim Barnes drawn in the same section in which Harry Vardon, the holder; Arnaud Massey, Abe Mitchell, Jack White, and Angel Dela Torre, the Spanish champion, are playing. A recent tournament promoted by the Bramshot club resulted in a victory for Vardon. There were 24 professionals engaged in the 18 holes medal round in the morning, and amongst these were five former open champions, as well as the strongest representatives of the younger school. It is noteworthy that two members of the Old Triumvirate were able to finish on top. Vardon's card of 73 being one stroke better than J. H. Taylor's return. Abe Mitchell was well to the fore, and his card of 75 enabled him to share third place with Charles Johns. An eliminating competition to decide the driving powers of the competitors was decided. Ted Ray was the winner by nearly 20 yards from W. L. Ritchie and Abe Mitchell. W. H. Horne, who has a reputation as a long hitter and holds a record for driving, was fourth. The measured distances of the prize-winners were: E. Ray (Osney), 273 yards 1 inch; W. L. Ritchie (Worplesdon), 258 yards 4 inches; A. Mitchell, (North Foreland), 258 yards 3 inches; W. H. Horne, (late Durban), 246 yards 16 inches.

S. P. A. Is Pleased. The announcement that the Minister of Finance proposes to reduce the tax on the cheaper class of sporting material will meet with the approval of the Sportsmen's Patriotic Association. A few days ago the secretary of that organization forwarded to Sir Henry Drayton a copy of a resolution passed at a recent meeting of the executive committee.

In their resolution the Sportsmen took no exception to the ordinary sportsman being called on to bear his share of the debt incurred by the war. The resolution drew the Minister's attention to their belief that a taxation on all classes of sporting material would have a tendency to discourage sport among school boys and working lads, and asked for an exemption of the tax on that class of goods. The exemptions now proposed conform to the wishes of the S.P.A.
