AND ALL THIS IS SUPPLIED QUITE APART FROM THE PUBLICATION OF THE NEWSPAPER AND GENERALLY OUTSIDE OF REGULAR HOURS—IT IS A SERVICE WHICH IT SEEMS NATURAL FOR A NEWSPAPER TO GIVE, AND BECAUSE OF LONG PRACTICE, FOR THE PEOPLE TO EXPECT FROM IT.

AND WHEN YOU READ YOUR EVENING NEWSPAPER, WHAT A LOT IT CONTAINS IN ADDITION TO THE LATEST NEWS OF THE DAY. A MODERN DAILY HAS A DAILY COMIC AND THE NEWSPAPERS OF TO-DAY HAVE MADE "BRING-ING UP FATHER" AND "MUTT AND JEFF" VERITABLE MODERN DAY CLASSICS. IN ADDITION THERE ARE FASHION DEPARTMENTS, RELIGIOUS PAGES CONTAINING THE SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSONS, SHORT STORIES AND A WHOLE DEPARTMENT IN ITSELF FOR THE SCHOOL CHILDREN.
