A VERY CLOSE CALL.
Women Perhaps Fatally Hurt in Auto Accident.
Ottawa, Aug. 4.—One person was seriously, perhaps fatally, injured, another badly shaken up, whilst a third escaped injury by jumping, as the result of a motor car, owned by J. Robinson, Morrisburg, backing over a twenty-five-foot cliff towards the St. Lawrence river, on the River Road, one mile east of Morrisburg, at nine o'clock Sunday morning.
Mrs. Simon Hutt, aged sixty-seven years, of Berwick, was the most seriously injured, she having had two ribs and her collar bone broken, and suffered internal injuries. J.
