One thousand harvest hands for western provinces left New Brunswick, on Friday, while Nova Scotia sent nearly two thousand.

John Farnell, one of the Winnipeg strike leaders, was given a jail term of nine months for seditious utterances, to be released.

Geo. S. Lyon, Seymour Lyon, and W. J. Thompson of Toronto, have been selected on the Canadian golf team to meet the United States team at Roslyn, L.I.

Byron Todd, about nine years of age, only son of Mr. and Mrs. E. Todd, Lindsay, fell from a launch crossing Cameron Lake, near Fenelon Falls, and was drowned.

P. W. Ellis, George Wright, and Fred R. Miller were appointed by Toronto Council as a Transportation Commission to manage and operate the street railway system of Toronto on the expiration of the franchise of the Toronto Railway Company in September, 1921.
