New York Brokers Grip U. S. Commerce Washington, Oct. 19.—A small coterie of New York stock exchange brokers have unlimited power over the finance of the country. John Skelton Williams, comptroller of currency, charged in a statement issued yesterday. These brokers, Williams stated, meet daily to fix the renewal rates on brokers' loans, which govern in nearly all New York banks. They are accountable to no one, Williams asserted, and their power gives them "a grip on the heart of our commerce."
