



The splendid antlered heads that adorn the homes of many sportsmen are evidence of the popularity of this animal,

In Canada the White-Tailed Deer is represented by three sub-species. The typical form is found in the east, the prairie form in Manitoba westward to the Rockies, and the Columbian White-Tail or Cotton-Tail Deer, which is found in southern British Columbia, between the Selkirks and

Cascade Ranges. West of these mountains the White-Tail is replaced by the Black-Tail or Coast Deer, light colored examples of which are sometimes taken for the White-Tail. The White-Tail of the west is known as the Red Deer.
