A Series of Talks on Music By Prof. C. C. Laughter, Mus. Bac. Sarnia.

No. V.—CHEST OF VIOLS. The family of the viols is generally considered to be various sized instruments played with the bow, by drawing it across the strings and causing them to vibrate thus producing the sound.

The most ancient viol on record is the Ravanastron, an ancient Hindoo instrument supposed to have been invented about 5000 years B.C. The sounding box resembles the bowl of a pipe and the long neck into which two pegs are inserted the stem. It has but two gut strings and is played with a bow of hair and bamboo. This instrument is still used among the Chinese and other Buddhist people. · An instrument of that type that we do know more about is the Rebec. This instrument is mentioned historically as appearing in Europe in the eighth century. It has a pear shaped body terminating in a slender neck, also having three strings and from the rebec we have the viol.


