A FAMOUS INTERPRETER

Michael Basso Was Well-known in Canadian Courts. In the death of Michael Basso, the Italian interpreter in the various courts of this country, the City of Toronto, in which he was so long a resident, has sustained a loss, comparable, with which the demise of many a widely known man has been trifling in comparison.

He was a man of sterling purpose, set in all his dealings, of clear insight and the highest integrity, with a heart both generous and large, with a keen appreciation of humor, and knowing the strong as well as the weak points of human nature; more particularly as exhibited in his fellow-countrymen.

Here are the merest outlines of the incident. On Christmas night of 1906 Francesco Capelli and a fellow-Italian, both under the influence of liquor, went to a party at the house of a settler named William Dow. While the merry-makers were dancing, suddenly the solitary lamp in the room was thrown to the ground and extinguished. In the darkness there were cries and revolver shots.

Twice the scaffold was erected within the walls of Parry Sound jail to hang the unfortunate Italian. Twice the ghastly instrument of doom was removed. At Mr. Basso's instance resort was had to the appellate tribunals. At this instance the trial judge became the prisoner's intercessor. At his instance Sir Wilfrid Laurier at the eleventh hour called a Cabinet council and commuted the death penalty.
