**THE ST. LAWRENCE MUST BE DEEPENED**  
Or Welland Canal Expenditure Will be Just Thrown Away.  
Toronto, Dec. 18.—The Canadian Deep Waterways and Power Association, on the second and final day of the annual meeting, passed resolutions urging the Ontario government to grant substantial financial aid to the association in carrying on operations, asking the dominion government to speed up work on the Welland canal and all public works with the purpose of relieving the unemployment situation, and asking the federal government to endorse the deepening of the St. Lawrence at the earliest possible moment. W. M. German, M.P. said that unless the St. Lawrence was deepened, the Welland canal and Toronto harbor expenditure would be as good as thrown away. O. E. Fleming, Windsor, was elected president, and J. M. Campbell, Kingston, a member of the executive committee.

**Canadian Warships.**  
Halifax, N.S., Dec. 18.—Hon. C. B. Ballantyne, who arrived last night with Sir Robert Borden, said the Canadian warships which arrive Tuesday would remain here until January 4th, when they leave for Bermuda and Trinidad, where they are to train with ships of the Imperial navy. From Trinidad they go to the Pacific coast, returning to Halifax in the spring.
