Daughter, who is raising nothing but a Poedle, has to have a Vacuum Cleaner to lighten her toil.

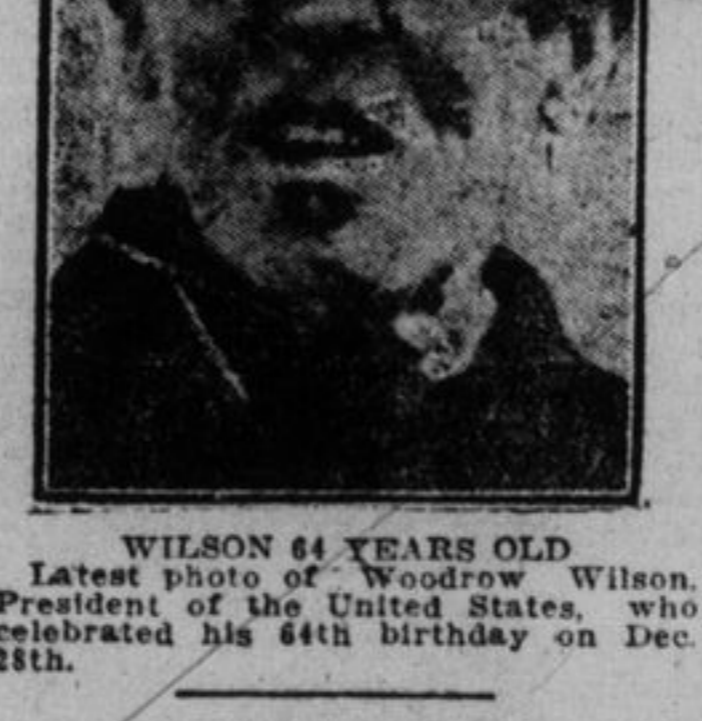
