FIFTIETH ANNIVERSARY

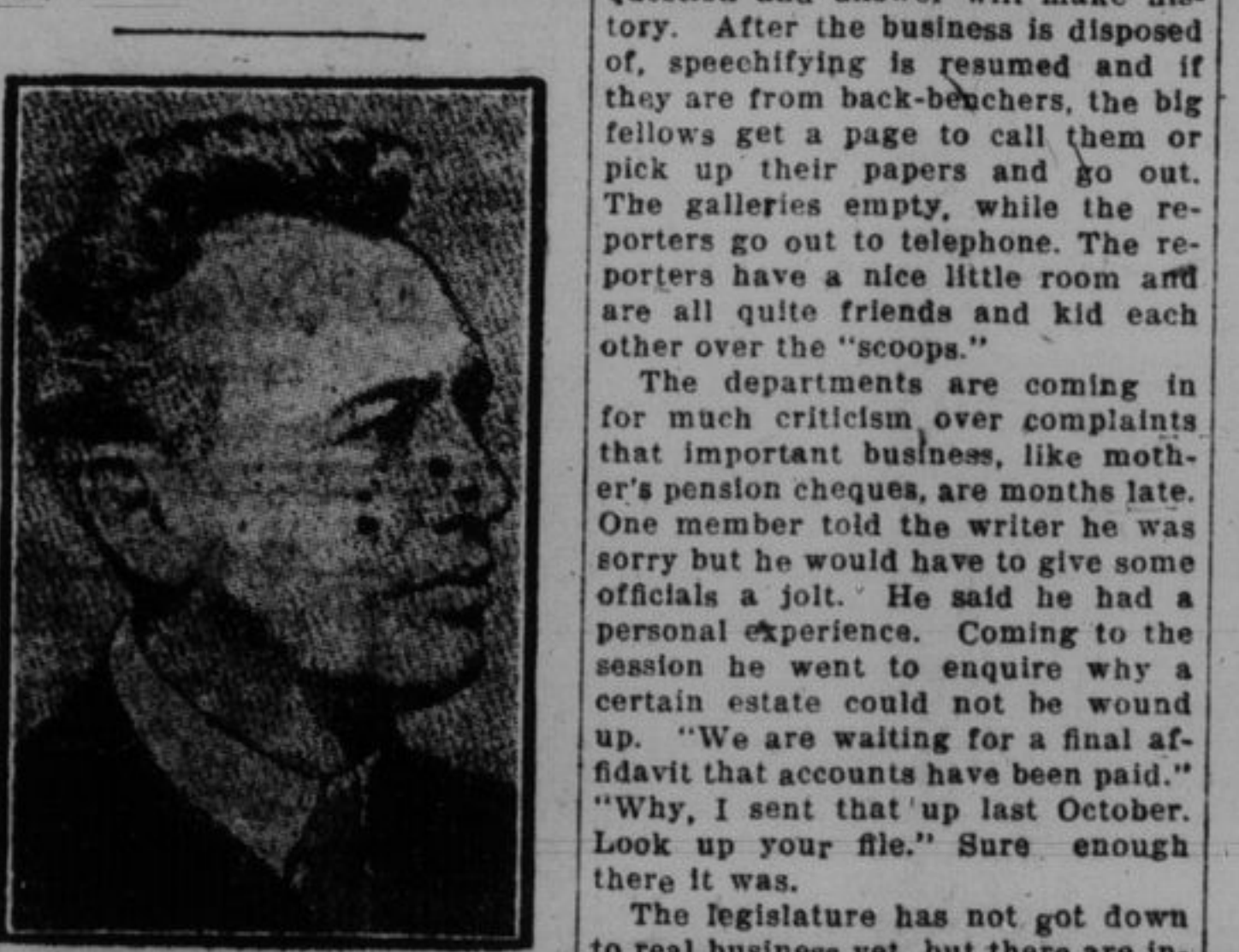
