KINGSTON FACTS

LOOK THEM OVER—THINK, TALK AND WRITE THEM—REMEMBER THEM

1. Location—At the junction of Lake Ontario and the St. Lawrence river, exactly half-way between Toronto and Montreal, the gateway to the "Thousand Islands," Canada's most picturesque holiday resort of international fame and the natural headquarters for visitors passing to and from those islands; in one of the best dairying and mixed farming districts in Ontario. 2. Population—In round numbers and with suburbs immediately joined to the city, 25,000. 3. Area—City proper, about 2,650 acres; no crowding; lots of room for expansion; on mountain ranges or other enclosing barriers. 4. Assessment—1920 — Taxable, \$16,001,577; exempt, \$5,005,030; total, \$21,006,607. 5. Transportation—Unequaled facilities by rail and water; city tapped by Canada's three great railways; Grand Trunk main line; Canadian Pacific, Canadian National and Canadian Pacific branch tapping territory to north from Kingston; divisional headquarters and stopping place for all important freight and passenger steamboat lines; an excellent harbour which must be developed further and will be; opening of enlarged Welland Canal makes Kingston the eastern shipping point for the great grain trade of Canada; the carrying through of the St. Lawrence Waterways scheme will make it a central trading point for deep water trade, east and west. 6. Building—Permits issued, 1920, \$524,936. Large new plants and buildings are to be constructed this year, including motion picture studios and laboratories, new artificial ice rink, the completion of Queen's University stadium, and others. 7. Available Factory Sites — Sufficient tracts of land for several large factories, city owned, bordered on one side by the main railway lines and on the other by Kingston's lower harbour; specially reserved for industries seeking location. 8. Power—Kingston is linked up with the Hydro-Electric Power System, and has an abundance of cheap power. A reserve plant is also located at Kingston Mills, within six miles of the city. The obvious advantages of electric power and the low price at which it is furnished here are practical inducements which cannot be overlooked. 9. Educational Facilities—One of the leading educational towns of Canada is Kingston. It is the seat of Queen's University, which grants degrees in Arts, Commerce, Divinity, Science and Medicine. The Royal Military College, with two hundred cadets from the finest families in the land, is also located here. There are also the Eastern Dairy School, Regiopolis College, Notre Dame Convent, Batescourt Private School, Kingston Collegiate Institute, twelve public schools in city and suburbs, three built within a few years and one constructed last year at a cost of \$135,000; three separate schools, with another in view; the School of Mining and Agriculture; the International Correspondence Schools; School of Navigation; and training schools for nurses in connection with the two large public hospitals and also one at Rockwood Hospital for the Insane. 10. Hospitals—Kingston General Hospital, large and modern, with new wing added lately and another planned; Hotel Dieu Hospital, also with new wing constructed since 1910; the Mowat Memorial Hospital for Consumptives; Rockwood Hospital for the Insane; Sydenham Hospital, one of the largest military hospitals in Canada; Calderwood Hospital for disabled soldiers. 11. Theatres—The Grand Opera House, for road attractions (under Trans-Canada direction); the Strand (Paramount); the Allen, one of the finest links in the Allen chain; Griffin's, newly renovated and decorated after many successful years; the King Edward. 12. Churches—Over 35 churches and missions with practically every denomination represented, two cathedrals. There are but a few of the more apparent facts about the city of Kingston, but one will notice that when gathered they represent a larger total than would be thought. More of these facts will be given in subsequent issues and those not on the surface will be brought out after the more visible advantages have been fully listed.

More Dye and Less Money. There are few people who do not have, at some time, some article of clothing which it seems a shame to discard. There are a great many people who wonder where they will buy new clothing if they do not throw away what they have, who cannot figure out where the money will come from for that purpose. The material is dyed and the owner has next thing to a new suit or coat. The expense is trifling compared with the cost of new clothes. In Kingston there are many facilities for having goods dyed. The work can be done right here in the city and can be done well. The man who does it has spared no expense to make his working apparatus and equipment the best that can be secured and he knows his business from start to finish. He also does pressing and repairing. Patton's Dye Works is the place, four or five doors from St. Andrew's church and three or four from the Y.M.C.A. on Princess street. This firm succeeded and took over the business of Montgomery's Dye Works.
