"JACK" WILLIAMS GOES TO MACKENZIE DISTRICT

Joins Ottawa Party to Establish Government Offices in Oil Fields.

Ottawa, April 20.—The oil find in the Mackenzie district is likely to gain world-wide fame in athletics, should some of the celebrated Ottawa athletes, who are going up there continue their good work in the north.

Amongst those from Ottawa, who have been appointed to the party, and who left yesterday are: Major D. L. McKeand, formerly of Hamilton, and a past president of the Canadian Rugby Football Union; also Capt. Eddie Phillips, president of the Ottawa Rowing Club; president of the Ottawa City Football League, and a man who has been prominent in sport for many years; "Jack" Williams, former captain of the Queen's and Ottawa Football Clubs, one of Canada's greatest halfbacks; and "Happy" Hayward, a member of the Ottawa Football Club executive and a former player for the Ottawa seconds, Quebec Rugby Union champions.

The party will travel west on the main line to Edmonton, and then go up north through Fort Norman, Fort Smith, Resolution, Providence, Wrigley, Good Hope, to Herschel. They have several 1 mile portages on their journey, and will go down the Mackenzie for many miles on scows. The trip is a hard one, but Major McKeand and his party are well fitted for it and will receive fresh supplies at the different stations.

CANADA IS FACING MORE COMPETITION

Paper Industry Exports to U.S. in February—Europe Getting Trade.

Washington, April 20.—Canada's paper industry is facing ever increasing competition from European countries in the United States market. This is shown by figures issued by the United States department of Commerce. During February last Canadian mills sent to the United States a total of 97,788,183 pounds of print paper, valued at \$6,077,320. This was a decline of three-quarters of a million dollars in business as compared with the previous month, the figure for January being 107,843,577 pounds, valued at \$6,814,218.
