The ministers were enjoined to draw up a report of the state of religion in their several congregations and neighborhoods, to be transmitted for the information of the General Assembly; and the different presbyteries were directed within their bounds to see that seesions should be regularly organized and records kept of their proceedings. A standing commission was apcointed to watch over the general interests of the church. 
