APPALLING CRIME

LIST OF SINN FEIN

Sir Hamar Greenwood Tells of 77 Murders in Two Weeks in Ireland.

London, June 4.-Ireland was to the forefront during the question period in the house of commons. Lloyd George and Sir Hamar Greenwood, the chief secretary, being bombarded with inquiries regarding recent events there.

The chief secretary said that since Jan. 1st, 1921, six women had been murdered, seven wounded and three kidnapped by the Sinn Feiners. During the fortnight ending May 28th. twenty police, eight military and forty civilian deaths were reported by the police. There were nine assassinations and two attempted assassinations of ex-service men reported in the same period. No evidence incriminating the crown forces was forthcoming during the month of

Asked whether the policy of reprisals had received the approval of the cabinet, the prime minister said that the military authorities were authorized to take such action as was necessary and justified by the military code of repression of rebellion and the restoration of order.

The Employees' Terms Received by the Hydro.

Toronto, June 4 .-- Wage increases averaging \$10 a month are contained in a proposed wage schedule sent to Sir Adam Beck by union electrical workers on the Central Ontario Hydro-Electric System through their organization, the Canadian Electrical Trades Union.

One hundred and thirty men are directly mentioned in the agreement. They are employed in the stations of the system at Oshawa, Bowmanville, Port Hope, Cobourg, Trenton, Frankford, Campbellford, Healey Falls, Peterboro, Millbrook, Lindsay, Fenelor Falls, Lehigh, Belleville, Ivanhoe, Napanee, Deseronto and Madoc. 
