CANADA HOLDS SECOND POSITION IN AUTOS

Canada, with one car to every 21 persons, is the second largest automobile user in the world. The United States leads, followed by Canada, New Zealand, Australia, Cuba and the United Kingdom in order of importance.

RECOVERING LOSSES.

Stocks Gained Much of the Fall They Recently Took.

In their weekly report on the unlisted market, A. J. Pattison Jr. & Co., Toronto, say that the stocks which have during the last few weeks been under pressure recovered, gaining in most cases a great portion of the former losses. Those stocks which did not follow the general trend of the market and sell off in the past weeks are now declining to prices that should have been current some time ago. Stocks continue to pass into strong hands on every decline with the result that the market is in a technically better position than it has been in the last year. Present buyers are content to sit back and hold for a long pull and as all proven securities are on the bargain counter at prevailing prices, any general wave of buying would move the market considerably higher before any quantity of stock would be met. There still exists an irregularity of prices that is hard to account for. Many issues are by comparison too high and others too low. Fluctuations occur that make the market look decidedly spotty, this, however, is usual at the end of either a bull or bear movement. The market of the past week was moderately active with prices generally higher than at last week's close.

Imperial Oil, after fluctuating considerably, closed unchanged from last week. Goodyear Tire Preferred was sought after in anticipation of the meeting Monday next, many buyers feeling that some action would be taken on the dividend. This is, however, out of the question and as it is apt to be many months before even a portion of the dividend is resumed, Goodyear should sell lower than the present quote, 43 to 48. Sterling Bank receded, to offer at 165 without any bid, due to the offering in the market of a fair size block of stock. Canadian Westinghouse was off a point at 101 1/4 to 102 1/4. Canadian Oil Common sold down to offered at 53 without any great amount of stock changing hands. Alberta Pacific Grain Preferred improved to 80 1/4 to 82 on little trading. Cockshutt Flow Preferred was quiet, unchanged from last week. Western Grocers Preferred was again in demand but little stock was forthcoming, the closing quotation was 63 bid, none offered. Rior-dan issues were quiet, the Common closing 1 1/2 to 2 and the Preferred offered at 15.
