The French of the revolution tried the same thing.

They, too, declared God abolished and for a long time it indeed seemed that His countenance was forever hidden from man by the blood that flowed in rivers from the guillotines, and by the flames that laughed devilishly from the torture pyres, and that His ear was closed against the curses, the wailings and the shrieks of anguish and despair that turned France into an inferno.

But sanity and God returned together.

There were many ghastly graves to close up, many gaping wounds to heal, many bitter woes to ameliorate in the wrecked nation for God, who cannot be abolished, can punish and forgive.

The people of the far Arctic village know little of history. The lesson must be written out for them in their own blood.

Alas. Many far more learned, far wiser than they, refuse to read from the open page of life that God cannot be abolished.

The czar sometime may be abolished—and happy the people that can set up in his stead a government of good order and justice, upon which God may smile.

Churches may be abolished or decay, priests may be abolished or disregarded, creeds and rituals may be abolished or forgotten, but God can no more be abolished by manifesto of men than can the steady march of time or the eternal circling of the stars be stopped by a puny cry in the dark.


