is the official table, with eggs quoted by the dozen and other items by the pound, except milk, which is priced by the quart:

Table comparing prices of items like Pure lard, Fresh eggs, Milk, etc. between Kingston, Dominion Average, and Ontario Average.

Bread, Flour and Cereals.

The majority of items coming under the classification of bread, flour and cereals show the Kingston prices are below the average.

Table comparing prices of bread, flour, and cereals like Pread, Soda biscuits, Spring wheat flour, etc.

Vegetables and Fruit.

Fresh and canned vegetables and fruits also show a balance on the right side so far as Kingston is concerned, practically every item on this list being cheaper here than in the majority of places in Canada.

Table comparing prices of vegetables and fruits like Canned tomatoes, Canned peas, Canned corn, etc.

Jams and Canned Fruits.

In this department, as in the preceding ones, the Kingston prices have the advantage all along the line. In every case they are below the average for the dominion and for Ontario.

Table comparing prices of jams and canned fruits like Strawberry jam, Raspberry jam, Peaches, etc.

Miscellaneous Groceries.

This splendid record of cheap living costs is maintained throughout the complete list of miscellaneous staple lines of groceries, including tea, coffee, sugar and other articles of common use in the kitchen.

Table comparing prices of miscellaneous groceries like Gran. Sugar, Yellow sugar, Tea, Green, etc.

Coal and Wood.

That completes the list of foodstuffs, and the next article to be considered is fuel, both coal and wood. In this department Kingston does not make quite so good a showing as in some of the others.

House Rents.

In the matter of house rents there is considerable room for difference of opinion, and there may be some who will question the correctness of the figures given by the Labor Gazette.

The Summary.

A summary of all these prices bears out this contention exactly: By taking one single unit of each of these items, and adding them all together, and taking only the six-roomed house with conveniences...

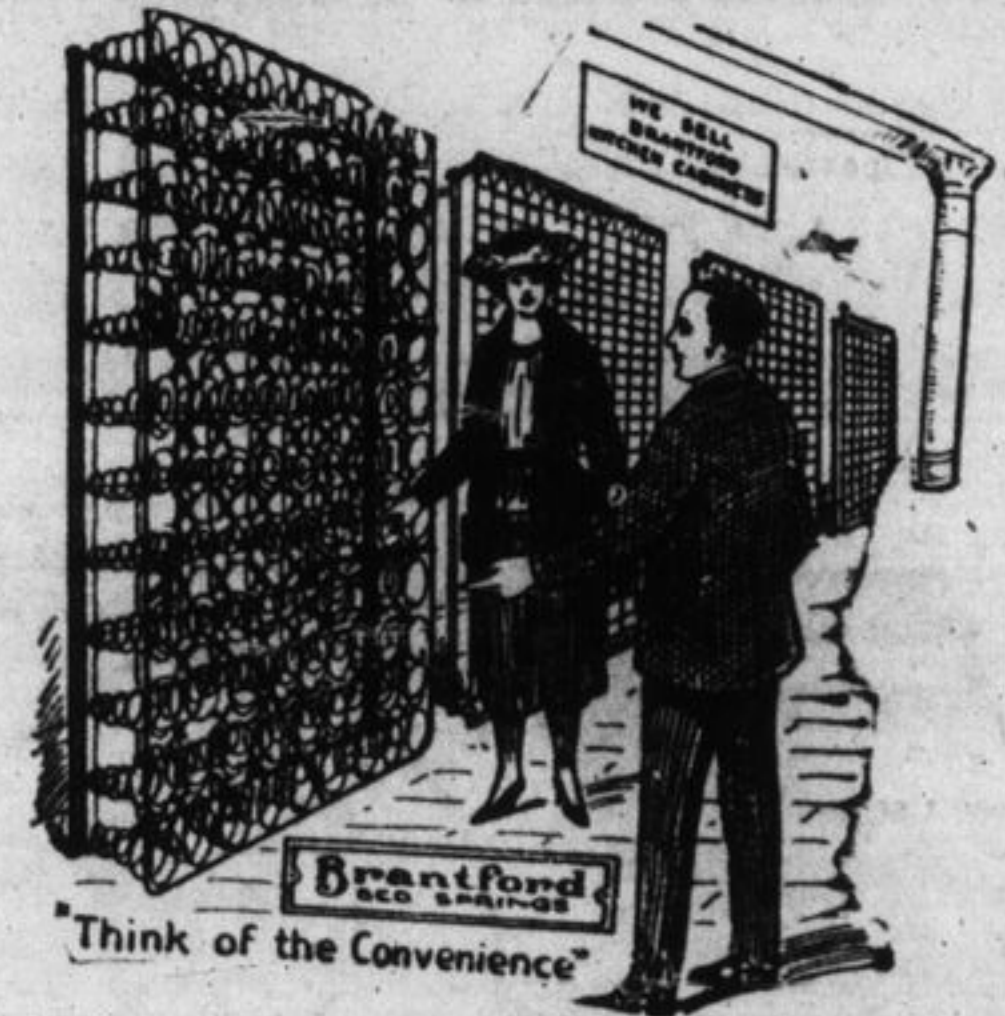
