EXHIBITION TRAIN COMING

To Be Here on Nov. 14—Canadian National-Grand Trunk All-Steel Train.

An unique opportunity will on Nov. 14th be afforded the residents of Kingston and vicinity of inspecting one of the trains which the Canadian National Railways employs in its daily across-Canada service.

The train is of outstanding interest in a two-fold sense. In first place it shows the kind of locomotive and cars that are being used in the trans-continental service, while in the second place it is an ocular demonstration of the high class locomotives and railway cars which are being made in the factories of the dominion.

The train is complete in every respect, being composed of sleeping car,

dining car, day coach, tourist car, colonist car, and express car. Each car is the embodiment of the latest and most up-to-date ideas designed to secure for the traveller the maximum of comfort and safety. Steel equipment is employed in every instance.

Practically all the comforts of home life are provided by the sleeping car attached to the train. Those who desire more than the usual measure of sleeping car privacy can by a simple device be accommodated with individual sections. The interior of the car is finished in mahogany. Seats are of the latest design in friezelet short nap. Lighting is by electricity throughout. The car is heated by the largest size of Pullman standard type of hot water heater. Berths are equipped with the latest conveniences. The water supply is obtained from underfed tanks. By the electric-driven suction fans installed, the air of the car can be changed every twenty minutes. The cost of a car of this kind is \$53,000.

The dining car has seating capacity for thirty persons. It is finished in quarter-cut oak, and is equipped with the latest innovations in respect to cooking facilities, lighting arrangements, and the convenience of travellers. Housewives will be particularly interested in the kitchen. Among the features of its equipment are removable dining tables, hot tables for cooked meats and poultry, and special arrangements for heating cups and dishes. Refrigerators are equipped with the Bohn system of refrigeration, separate compartments being provided for poultry, meats, milk and vegetables. Stewards, chefs, and waiters are on hand to explain equipment and reveal the mysteries appertaining to the kitchen and dining room of a travelling hotel. Cost of the dining car such as the one on exhibition is \$46,000.

To the average citizen who may contemplate a cross-Canada trip in a less expensive way than in the standard sleeper, the tourist car shows is of particular interest. It is just as substantially built as the standard sleeper and is exceedingly well equipped with modern conveniences but is less luxuriously finished. The car is lighted by electricity, one peculiar feature of which is the location of electric lamps under the seats for use at night when the ceiling lights are out. The car is also equipped with a modern kitchen, containing range, refrigerator, sink, cupboard, etc., for the convenience of travellers who wish to provide their own meals. This car cost \$39,000.

colonist car. The car shown is of an improved type, and is such as is now used by the Canadian National Railways in harvesters' excursions. The berths are adjustable in order to accommodate themselves to day or night travel. A car of this kind costs \$35,500.

The day coach is of the well-known standard type used on the Canadian National system, and cost \$33,000. The express car is the type that is regularly used by the Canadian National Express Company.

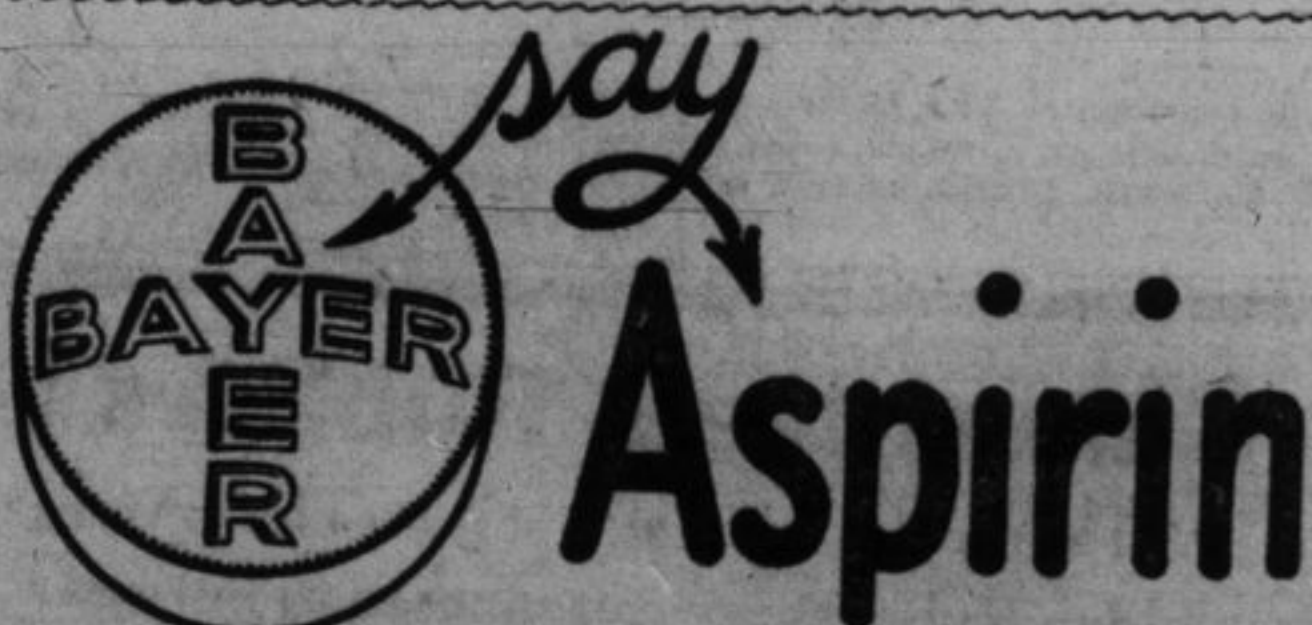
Total cost to reproduce a train such as that now on exhibition would be approximately \$370,000, cars alone costing over \$300,000. A similar train was shown at the Canadian National Exhibition, and was visited by 100,000 people.

The train is accompanied by a staff of men efficient in the various departments appertaining thereto. Their office is to explain by practical demonstrations the "why and the wherefore" of the equipment on an across-Canada train such as that in use on the Canadian National Railways system. Train will be placed at G.T.R. station at Ontario street and will be open for inspection from 9 a.m. to 10 p.m.

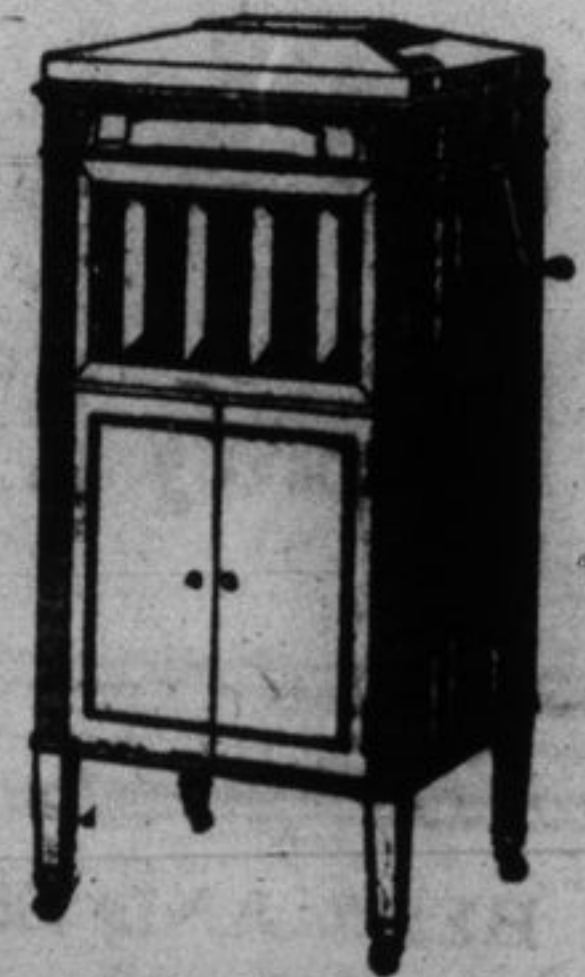
