ARGOS WIND UP WITH NO DEFEATS

Blank Eskimos 23-0 Though Westerners Line Much Superior.

Varsity Stadium, Dec. 3.—Argonauts had no particular difficulty in winning the Canadian rugby championship. They scored 23 points and blanked the western champions, the Edmonton Eskimos. Ten thousand people saw the game, which was never in doubt. Argonauts broke to the front with two easy touchdowns, scored as the result of errors in the first period and were never seriously threatened.

The Eskimos showed up with a team of magnificent line buckers and at various times during the play bucked the Argonaut wing line all over the field. But just when it looked as if this heavy line smashing would result in a score, a tumble or a penalty would relieve the Argonauts' goal line. As was anticipated, the Eskimos failed utterly to stop the Argonauts around the end offensive, while the regular backfield was in action. When Conacher or Batstone were on the side lines, they did on several occasions break it up, but when the "three marketeers"—Cochrane, Hatstone and Conacher—were on the field of battle they waded through for long gains—that is where Argos made their big gains. Backed up as it was by a series of trick plays and fakes which opened out the Eskimo wing line when the Argonauts needed a touchdown.

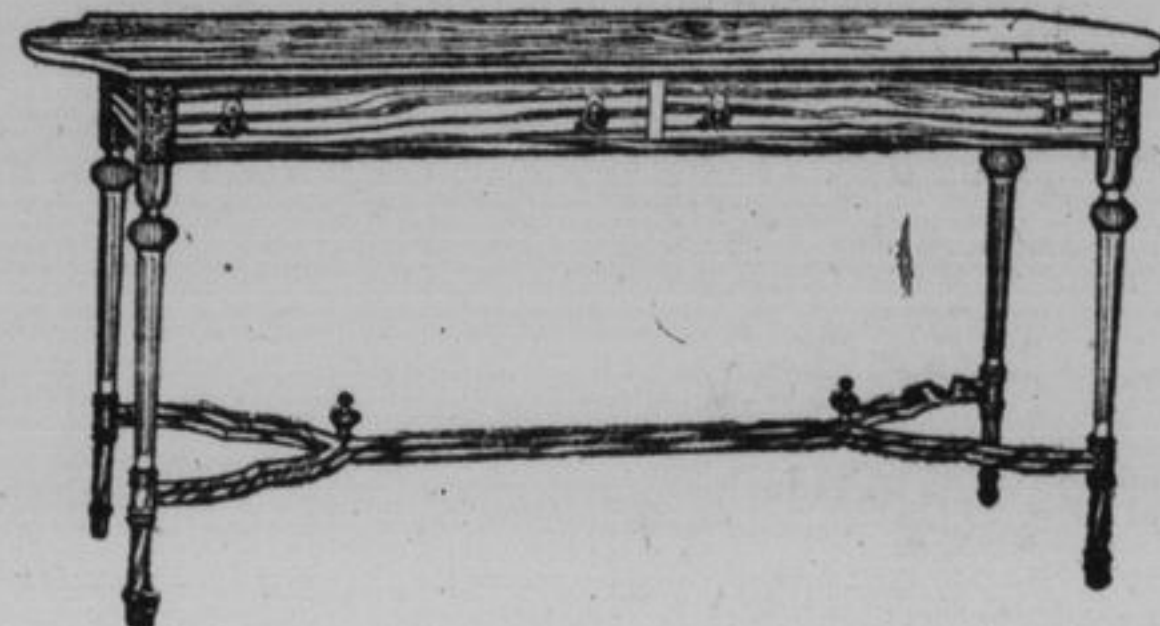
