"In 1886, when the Assessment Act was amended, I have no doubt that the legislature was perfectly honest and sincere when it decreed that the directors of any corporation or limited liability company might vote to separate schools the taxes of that company in proportion to the amount of stock held in that company by such Catholic directors. That is the law. On the face of it, it looks fair, but it isn't operative. For instance, you have in Kingston large national banks, which have branches from the Atlantic to the Pacific. Who is going to determine the religious persuasion of the stockholders, scattered all over Canada, the United States and Europe? 
