Findlay is Identified by Finger Prints

Cornwall, Dec. 20.—Chief of Police Paterson has received a letter from Albert J. Cawdron, of Ottawa, superintendent director of criminal investigation. Royal Canadian Mounted Police, in reply to the finger prints of Charles R. Bradley, alias Harry Forbes Findlay, the young man in custody here awaiting trial on charges of passing worthless checks. According to the finger prints sent by Chief Paterson, Supt. Cawdron says they are identical with those of No. 13394, Harry F.
