The Hudson Athletic Association of Boston is composed entirely of Syrians. Bobby Joseph, the feather-weight boxer, is the organization's star performer.

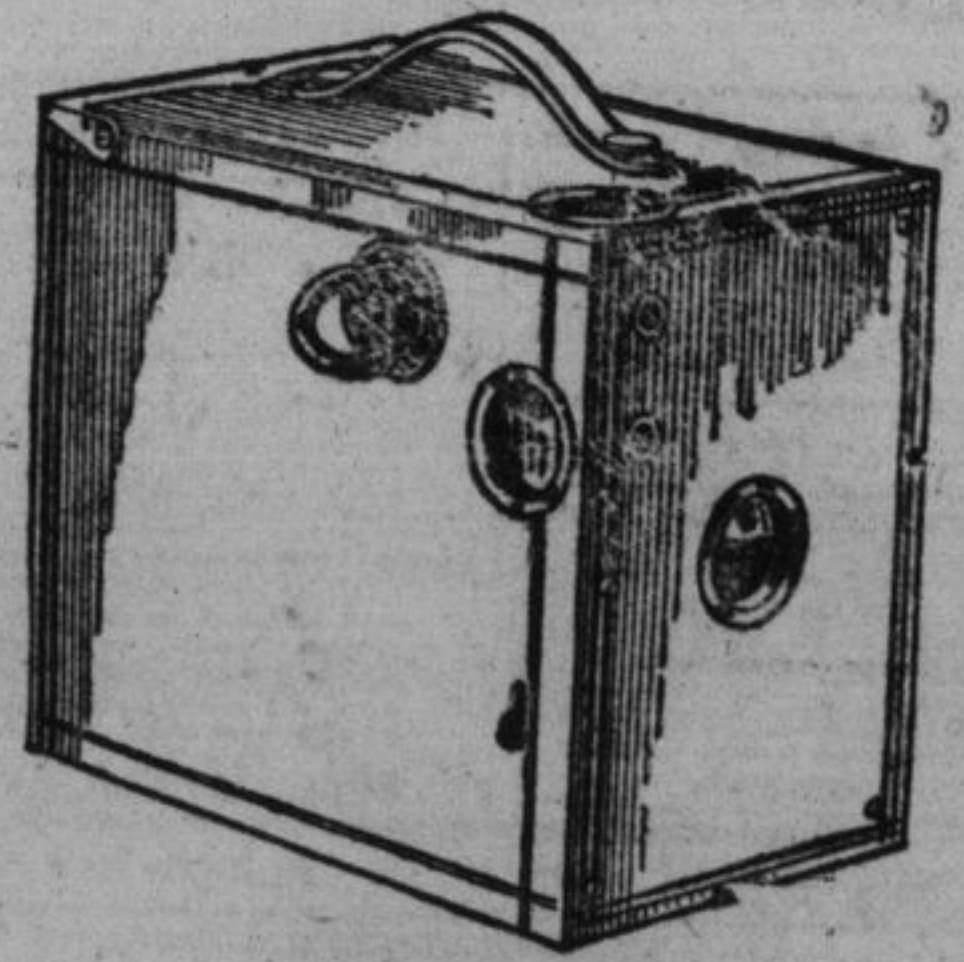
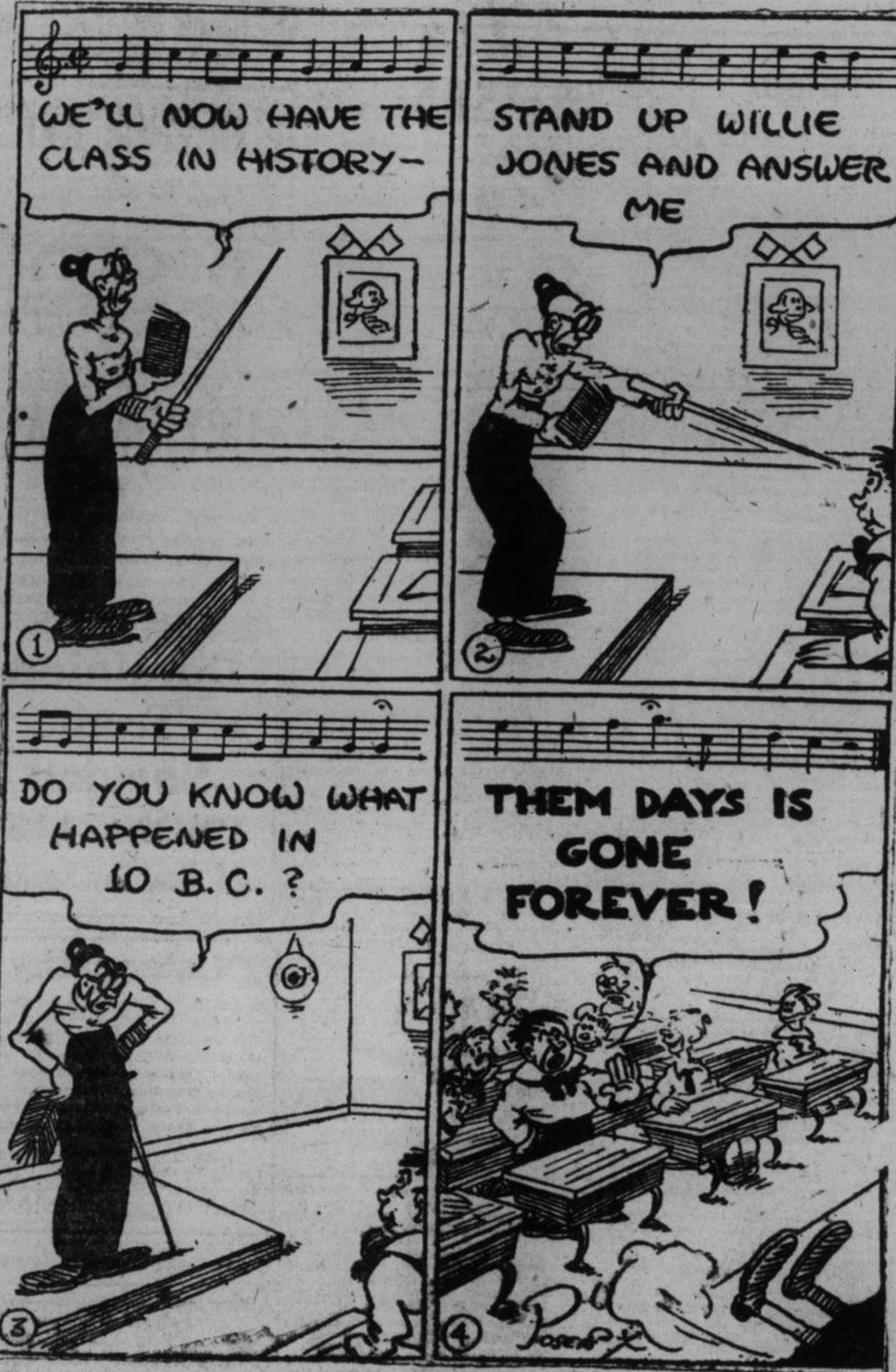
Plans for the Yankees' new ball park in New York call for a three-deck concrete grandstand to cost

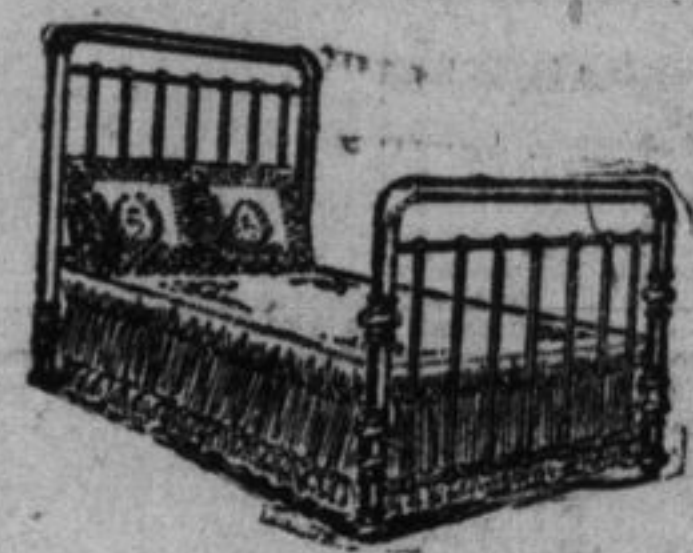
