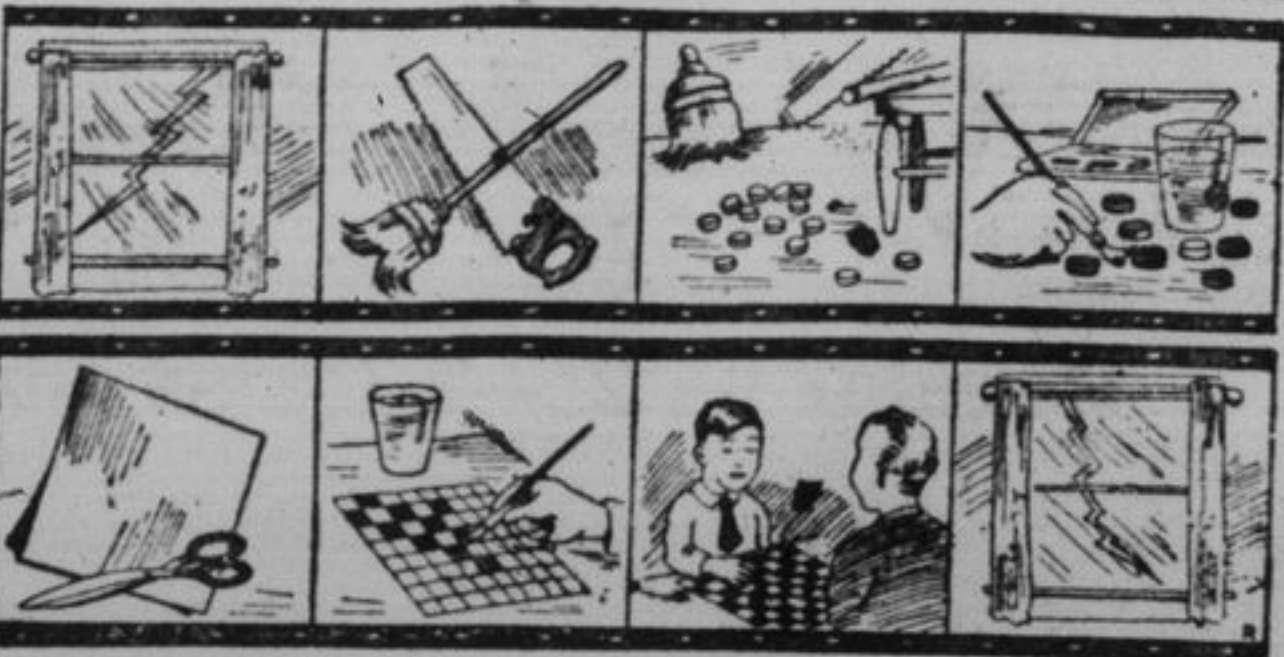

Now has board divided into two-inch squares. Water colors again. Johnny begins at left-hand corner of the board and farthest from him and makes that square black.



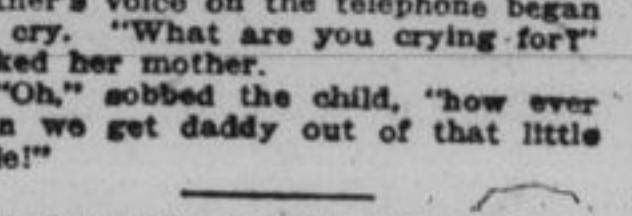

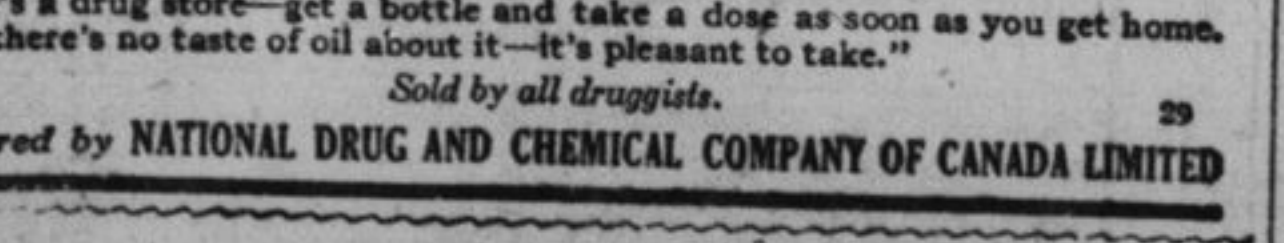
Best Goods Recovered
