Elbowing Out a King.

In the ordinary course of International Lessons in Old Testament history which we have been following to-day's theme would have been the reforms and rebuilding by good King Joash. But the Lesson Committee, recognizing the paramountcy of the Resurrection Story, provide this Easter Lesson as optional. Judah's King Joash is of small consequence alongside of the King of Life. The portion of the evidence assigned for special study is as follows: I quote from the Weymouth translation, for the sake of its freshness:-

'On that same first day of the week, when it was evening and, for fear of the Jews, the doors of the house where the disciples were, were locked, Jesus came and stood in their midst, and said unto them, "'Peace be to you!'

"Having said this He showed them His hands and also His side; and the disciples were filled with joy at seeing the Master. A second time, therefore, He said unto them,

"'Peace be to you! As the Father sent Me, I also now send you.' "Having said this, He breathed upon them and said.

" 'Receive the Holy Spirit. If you remit the sins of any persons, they remain remitted unto them. If you bind fast the sins of any, they remain bound.'
