METHODIST CONFERENCE

To Be Held Here in June—The Programme is Outlined.

The Methodist churches of the city are now in the early throes of billeting the Montreal annual conference, which will convene in Sydenham street church on Friday morning, June 2nd, under the presidency of Rev. W. S. Lennon, B.A., D.D. The ministerial session of the conference will convene several days earlier, namely, on Wednesday, May 31st, at 2 p.m. The conference is constituted of laymen and ministers in equal numbers, and has jurisdiction from Kingston on the west to Little Metis, Quebec. The ten districts into which the conference is divided comprise two hundred and twenty-three charges. As this is the last year of the quadrennium between the sessions of the general conference, and the elections to this legislative body of the church take place at the approaching annual conference, it is expected that the attendance will be a full one, numbering probably well over three hundred to five hundred, and the work of providing suitable entertainment for these delegates will tax the ability of the Methodist people of the city.

Three or four features of the conference always attract special attention—the laymen's banquet, which is to take place this year on Thursday evening, June 1st, in Grant Hall; the election of the new president, which will occur on Friday morning immediately after the opening of the general session of the conference; the reception service on Friday evening, when probationers who have completed their course for the ministry are received into full connection with the conference; and the ordination service on Sunday morning. The general superintendent of the Methodist church, Rev. S. D. Chown, D.D., L.L.D., will preach the ordination sermon. It is expected also that the Rev. Dr. Wallace MacMullen, district superintendent of New York district of the M.E. church, along with Premier Drury of Ontario, Rev. Dr. MacMullen will also conduct the spiritual conferences with which each day begins, and will preach in the conference church at the evening service. The church and many of those of other denominations will be occupied on conference Sunday by ministerial members of the conference.

HE PUTS NO BELIEF IN SPIRITUALISM

Willing to Wager Conan Doyle \$5,000 He Can Expose Manifestations.

New York, April 17.—Sir Arthur Conan Doyle is challenged to a show down on his faith in spirits by Jos. F. Rinn, of Brooklyn, a produce broker and expert magician.

"I'll wager \$5,000, to be deposited to Sir Arthur's credit, in my bank, and held until the result of the test is known, if he will let me produce some 'psychic phenomena' for him, and admit it if he finds I can do it as well as a medium can," Rinn said, decisively.

"My colleagues in the Society of American Magicians can produce 'psychic phenomena' which would knock Sir Arthur over. He is simply the dupe of clever and unscrupulous mediums, and I could prove it if given the opportunity."

Rinn, who has devoted his spare time for years to exposing mediums, ghost-producers and other occult workers, is planning a "spiritualistic seance" for next fall, at which all the popular "spiritualistic manifestations" will be produced and explained as plain vaudeville magic.
