Will Soon Talk to Mars On Wireless Telephone. Sydney, N.S., May 4.—"If there be intelligent life on Mars, Venus or any of the planets, I believe communication will be established between the earth and the people of these outer worlds through the medium of wireless telephony within the next decade," was the prediction of a Marconi expert today.

"Don't think I am drawing the long bow in making this prophecy, as I feel firmly convinced that provided there are people in the tenements of the sky with a civilization approaching ours, radio wireless will span the void that stretches between the earth and the planets and carry a spoken message to those with ears to hear."

To Be No Redistribution At Present Session. Ottawa, May 4.—Although the census of the dominion is practically completed there will be no redistribution bill during the present session. There has been some inclination to press for such a measure on the alleged ground that nobody can foresee when a dissolution may be precipitated. Hon. J. A. Robb, minister of trade and commerce, stated that, while the completion of the census was well under way, certain grave irregularities had been discovered, and that there had been "padding" in certain districts. A number of prosecutions had been instituted, and developments were expected.

My! Ladies Steal At Rummage Sales. From time to time, some of the ladies who are connected with church organizations and hold annual rummage sales, have been troubled with people who attend the sales for the purpose of "picking up" goods, and carrying them away without paying. On Thursday morning, three or four women were caught in the act of carrying goods out of the building where a sale was taking place, and were compelled to return them.

Winnipeg, May 4.—Sentences of five years in Stony Mountain penitentiary with five and ten lashes were passed on Mike Cozime and Frank Sawajowski, coauthors of the robbery of \$5,000 on January 17th last, from the North Winnipeg branch of the Provincial Savings Bank, by Magistrate Sir Hugh Macdonald in city police court.
