

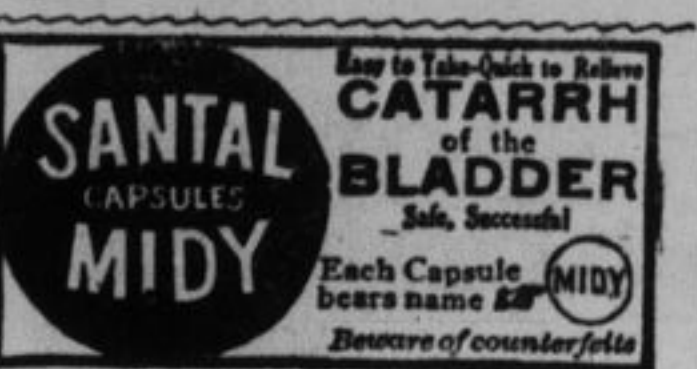

ON DUTY AMID THE SCORPIONS

The International Sunday School Lesson for July 2 is "Ezekiel, The Watchman of Israel."—Ezekiel 2:1—3:27.

If it did not sound a bit irreverent we might call this Lesson "God's Commencement Address to a Prophet." In the person of this man Ezekiel, we see summoned to stand, like a graduating class receiving the direct address of the speaker, all the preachers and teachers and editors and statesmen of our time.

That is a summons to bring the most cynical and routine-ridden standing. With the word itself sweeps in the consciousness that it the Lord Almighty ever speaks to anybody on this earth it must be, first, to mothers, and then to the men and women who teach their times—the preachers, the writers, the statesmen and the instructors of youth.

And the highest recognition and reward of such work, its crown of fabled laurel, is that it is direct service of the will of the living God. To be among those to whom the Lord speaks is great enough honor for both earth and heaven.

"Slacker" Prophets

Every worker with words, by voice or pen, should have a solemn session with himself in the light of this Divine appeal and of humanity's unique needs. Ezekiel's call fits us every one like a custom-made cloak.

Just as there are nowadays renegade newspapers, "slacker" preachers unillumined teachers and perfidious statesmen, so when Judah fell there were false prophets who saw their position only as a means to popularity and personal comfort.

When he was summoned to his life work, this aristocratic Jew, of priestly lineage, who was in exile in a colony of his countrymen along one of the canals near Babylon (I have seen the courses of those ancient canals still criss-crossing lower Mesopotamia), was told plainly that he was being called to no easy mission. He was promised bribe and thorn, instead of luxury, "and thou dost dwell among scorpions."

Relentlessly and vividly, all the difficulties of his task were laid before Ezekiel. That is God's way. He appeals to the heroic in us, rather than to the love of ease and safety. It is a poor fashion to recruit candidates for the Gospel ministry by promising them good salaries, assured positions and a comfortable pension at the end.

Trained in A Troubled Time

As yet, no new world leader has emerged from the war or from the graver international crisis that has followed it. This is one of the disappointments of our day. We expected a finer breed of captains for all walks of life to come out of that fiery furnace. There is still time, of course; but scanners of the horizon are frankly disappointed because from the severest ordeal of history have come men and women who mostly seem bent upon triviality, sensuality, materialism and small selfishness.

There are a hundred possible wrong ways of considering this great Lesson of Ezekiel, God's watchman on the walls of Judah; but the worst way of all is to deal with it merely as a historical incident dated in the sixth century before Christ, and located in the neighborhood of old Babylon, in Mesopotamia, down near the present city of Bagdad.

Some years ago it became my journalistic duty to investigate a horrible lynching in a church-going Pennsylvania town and some professional religious leaders, defenders of the lynchers, professed to be hurt because I pointed out that there was blood on the doorsteps of the churches of the community. They could not see it—though the truth was made clear twenty-five hundred years ago, in God's solemn warning to Ezekiel, which we to-day study. Here are the words:

"Son of man, I have made thee a watchman upon the house of Israel; therefore hear the word at my mouth, and give them warning from me. When I say unto the wicked, Thou shalt surely die; and thou givest him not warning, nor speakest to warn the wicked from his wicked way, to save his life; the same wicked man shall die in his iniquity; but his blood will I require at thine hand."

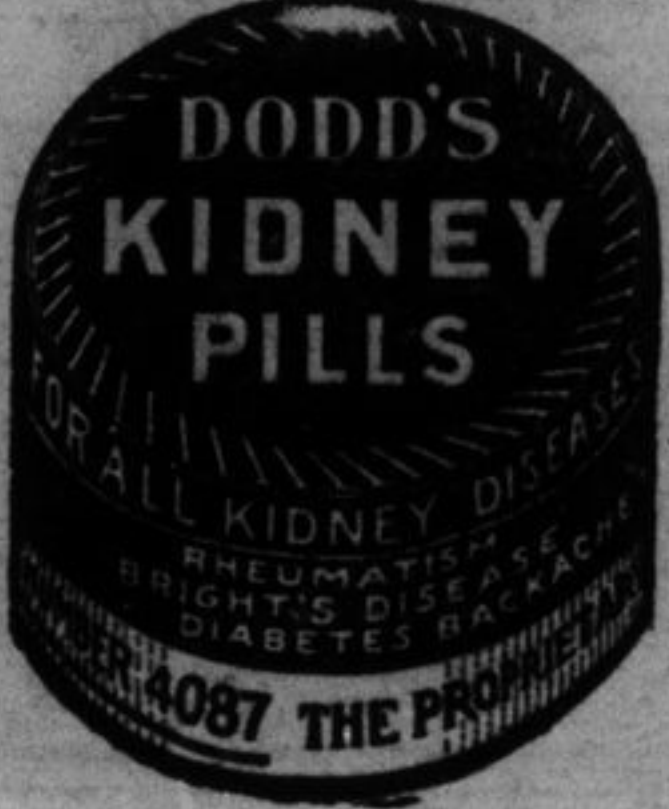

Justice, and W. N. Tilley, K.C. Mr. Newcombe has left for London to attend the sitting of the privy council.

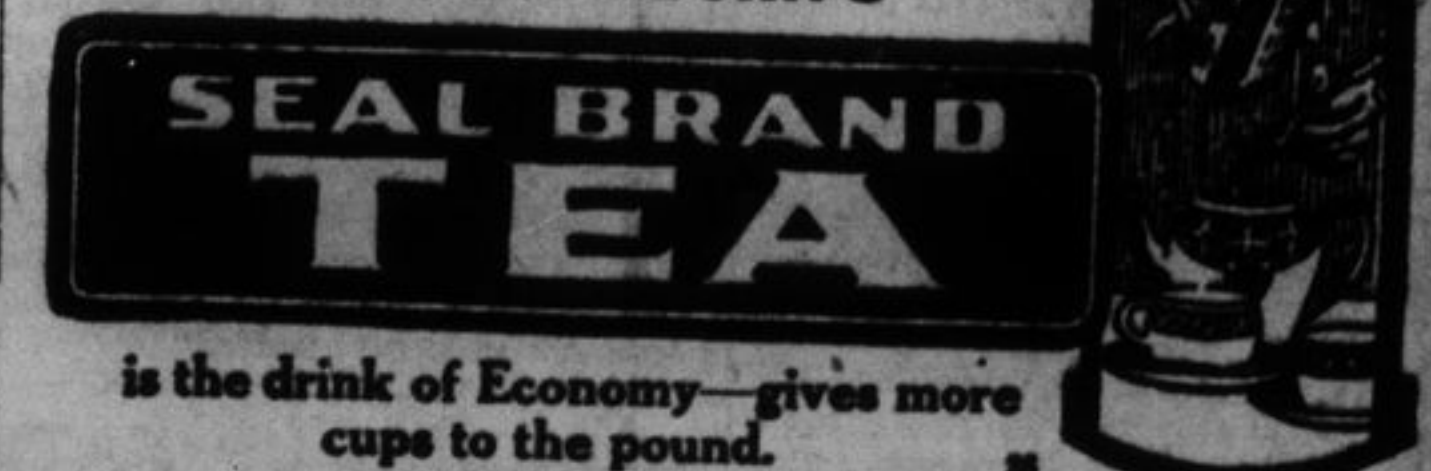
Trip of Inspection.
