Belleville, July 19.—The old George Cup, after a lengthy stay in Canada, has gone to the United States, to the Crescent Club of Watertown, N.Y. Eddie Lansing, after chasing the Toronto Scrapper many a hot weary mile around the course at Prinny's Cove at last got an answer to his prayers and in a good healthy snorter from southwest pushed, pulled and generally gawehawed his mahogany skinned malamute across the line forty-eight riproarious seconds ahead of Major Windeyer's Scrapper yesterday in the closest seesaw that the same ancient mug has ever seen.

Scrapper had won the first race by several city blocks and it looked as if the trophy was already tucked away by the Scrapper, but the breeze which had been fusing round northwest, firmly settled itself and proceeded to blow shingles off the roof.
